Salk Neighborhood Park Joint use

Development: The current estimated construction progress is 61%. Ongoing work includes biological surveys of noise levels, work on retaining walls and sidewalks, rough plumbing and electrical at the comfort station, excavating and backfilling of the sewer line, concrete curbs, overflow structure, and driveway concrete placement. This project is anticipated to be completed in late Spring.

Wagenheim Neighborhood Park Joint Use Facility: The current estimated construction progress is 90% complete. It is anticipated that the joint use area turf establishment period will be complete in Spring and the Walker site will be complete in early summer. 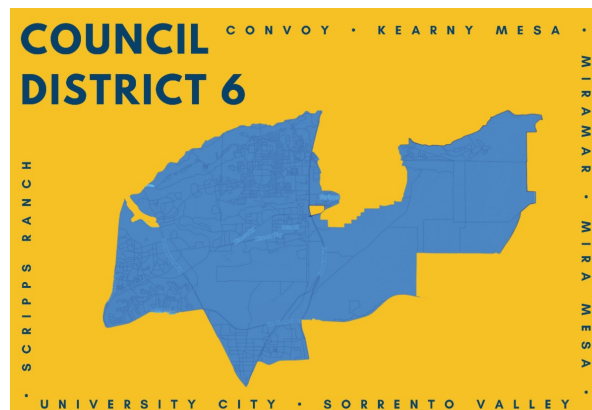
Mira Mesa Community Park Phase II Improvements:
