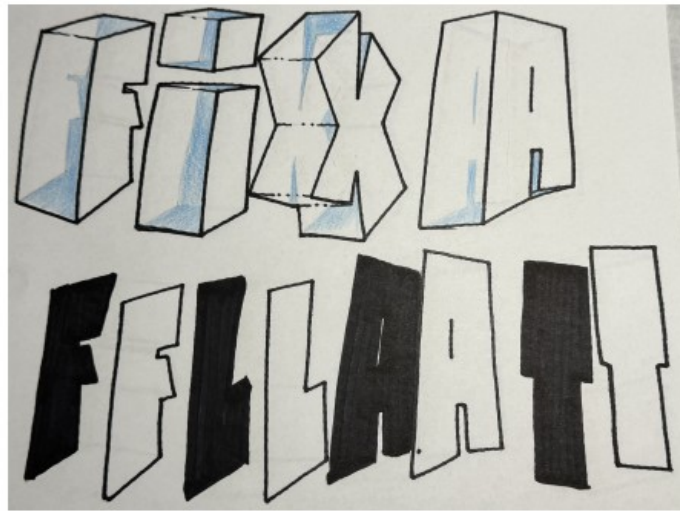
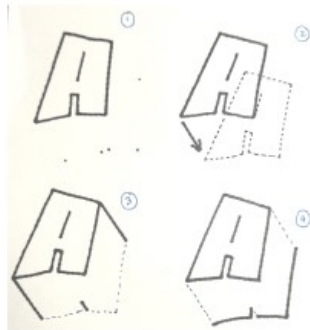


How-To Fix Your Flat Hand-Lettering with Legible Graffiti 3D Made Easy!

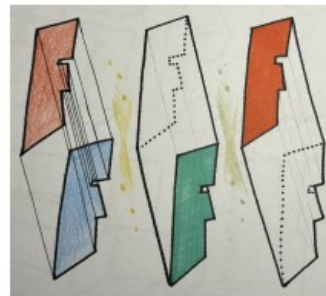
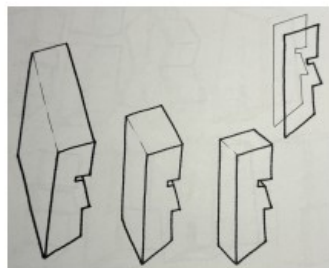
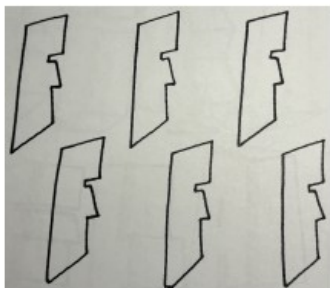

Fix A Flat, from 2D to 3D here is some BASIC BLOCKS fun!

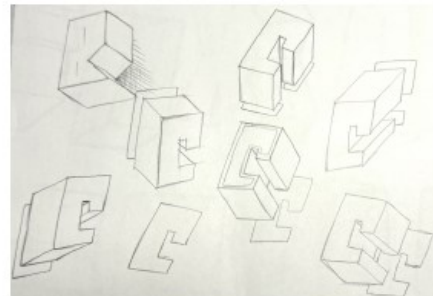


Step by step to block the Letter A



Here is the letter F. First there are six flat F's. Then there are three F's in 3D using two directions

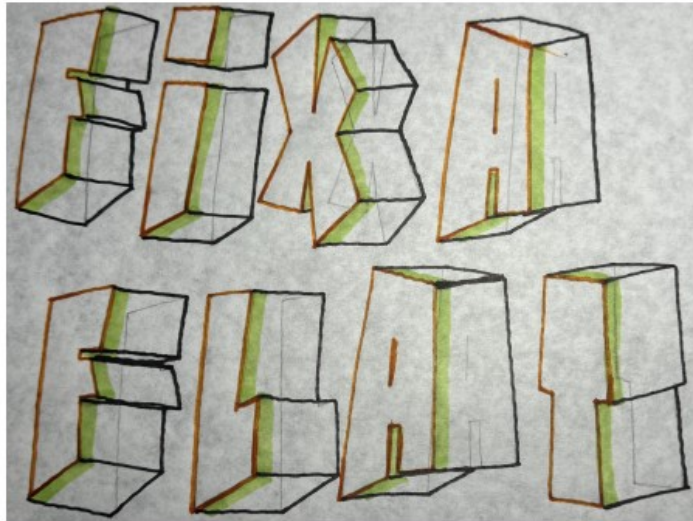
A 3D B and a bunch of 3D Cs



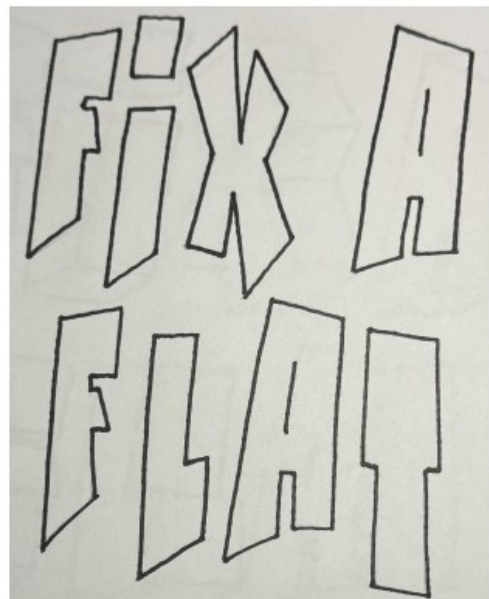


The word FIX in 3D, with colors and details.

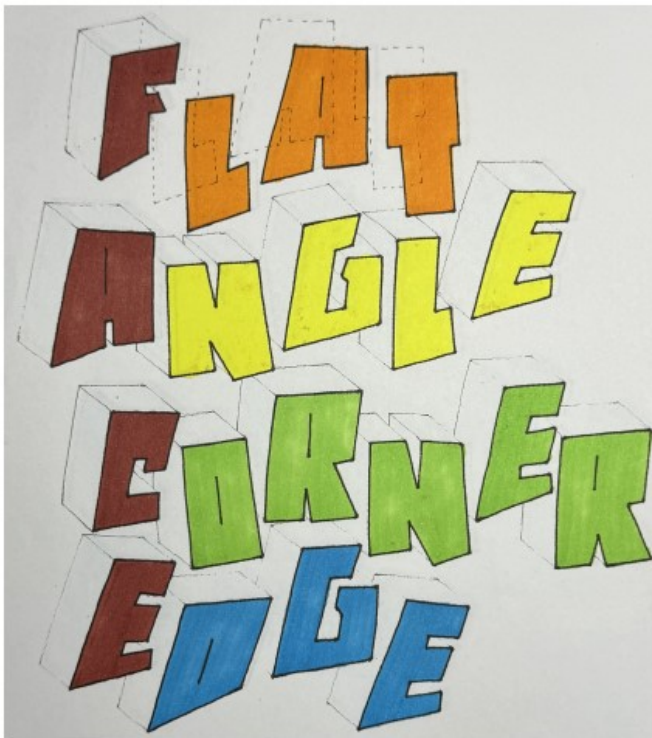
Fix A Flat in big block letters with a green stripe on the side.



For Legible Graffiti 3D Made Easy, just remember to use FACE when blocking letters. FACE stands for 1) Flat, 2) Angle, 3) Corner or Curves, 4) Edge. These four action-steps will block any shape, number, or letter. Action steps 5) color and 6) add details will complete the finished block or bubble letter. Do one letter at a time, when you are just



The best way to Fix-A-Flat is to have a flat-design layout to start with





Fix-A-Flat when you double up a letter with its same shape

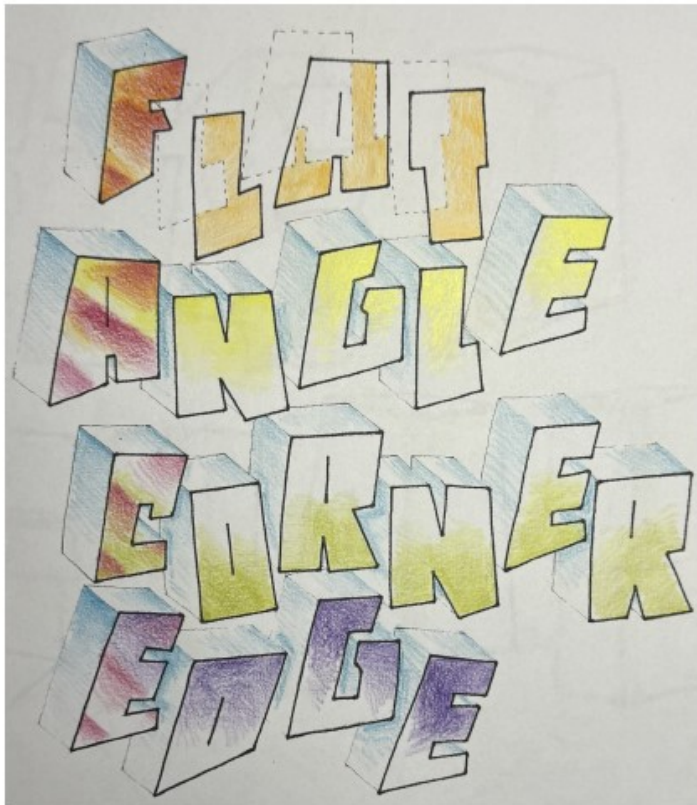


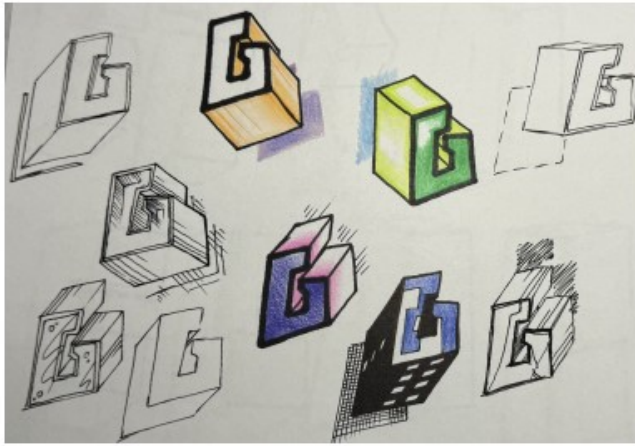
Here's a fun "flat" 3D design in colorful bright pink

Legible Graffiti action steps:

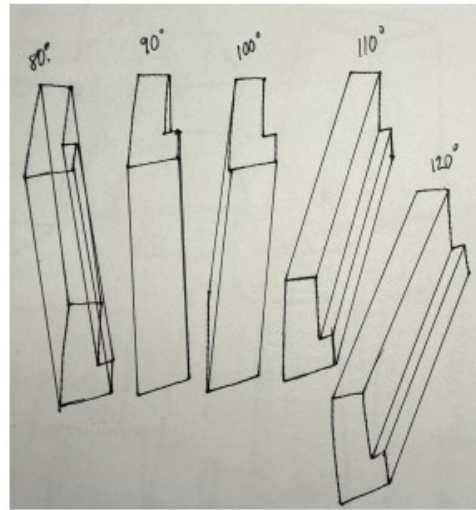
1. Flat (copy the original shape onto a new piece of paper)
2. Angle (move the shape in one direction)
3. Corner (connect the corners or curves of the shape to the original)
4. Edge (follow the outer edge to complete the blocked shape)
5. color (add colors to your 3D block or bubble letter)
6. detail (add details or embellishments to your design)

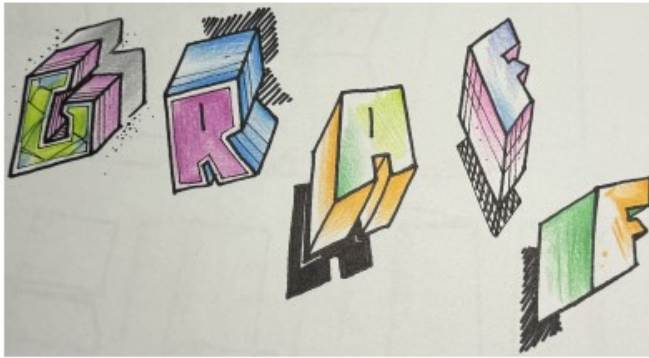




There are many different 3D letter G's here.

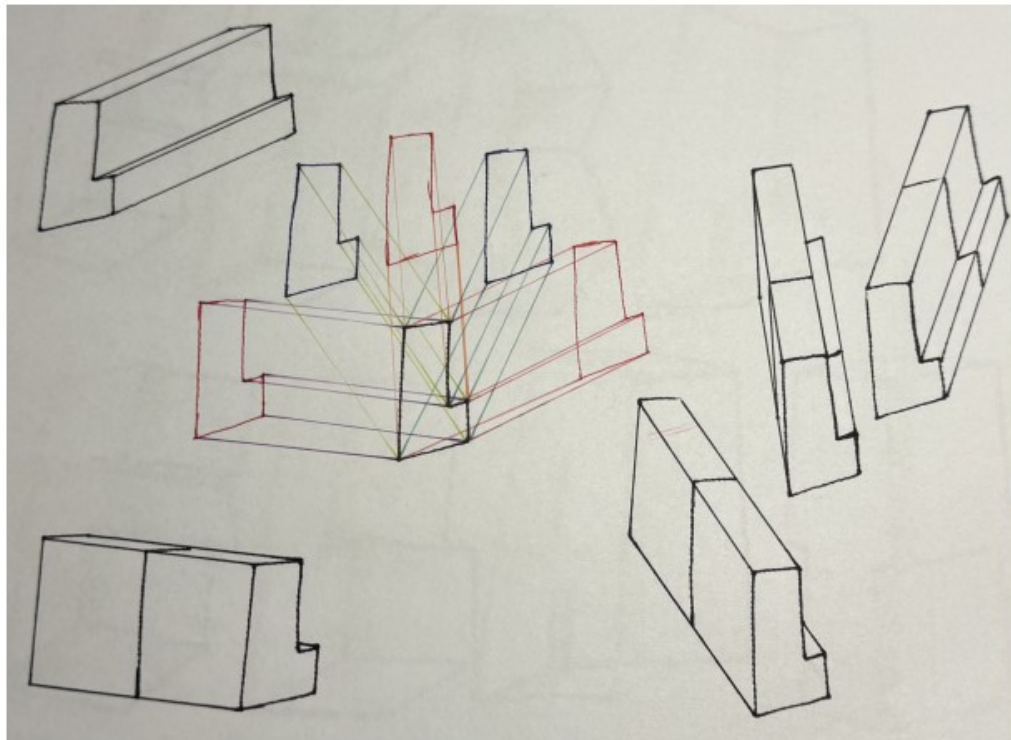


The Letter L from different angles. These 3D L letters are similar to couches.



Here I wrote the word GRAFF in 3D, using different angles to block each letter to give this design a feeling of movement.

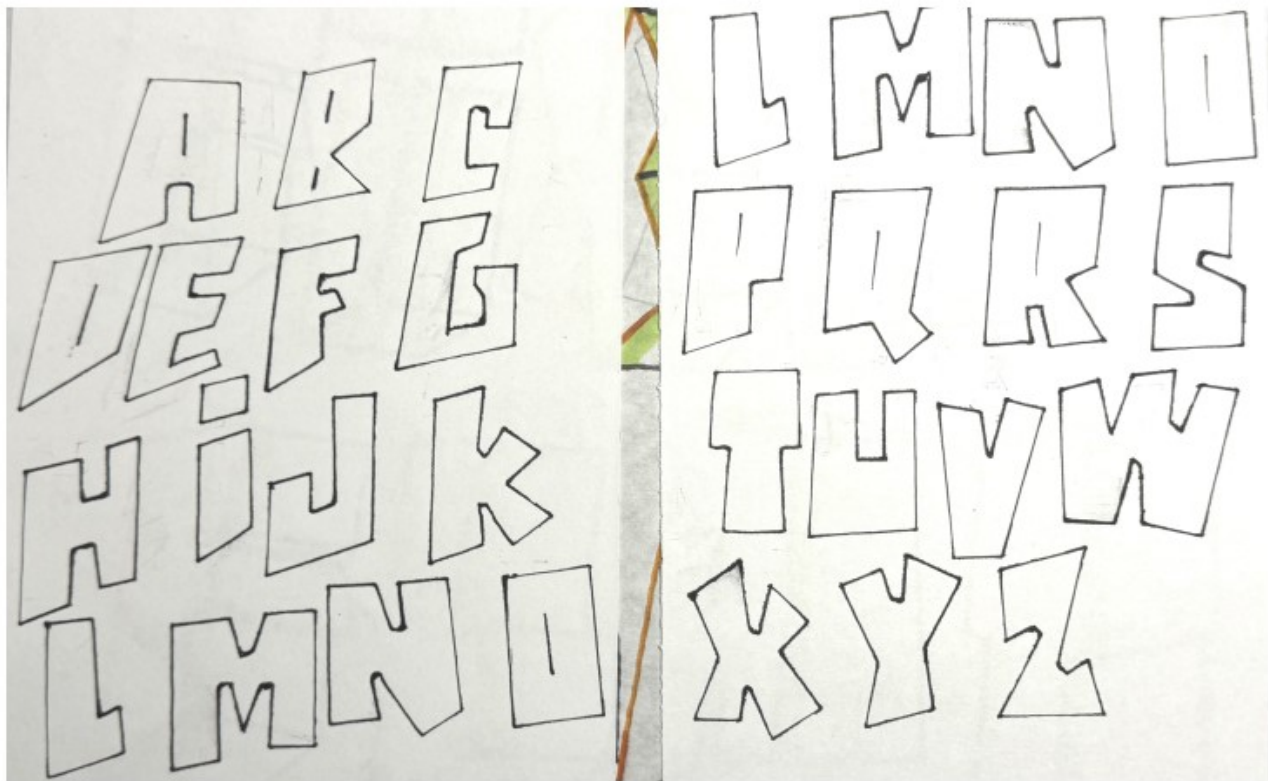
Here I made many different 3D L forms. Remember, a flat shape is two dimensional (2D), and a form is like a three dimensional (3D) block.



SUPPLIES

1. **Paper** (BLANK COPY PAPER WORKS GREAT.)
2. **Lightboard or Window** (TO SEE THRU THE PAPER)
3. **Markers** (COLORED PENCILS, CRAYONS, PASTELS, PAINT PENS... SOMETHING TO MARK THE PAPER WITH).

For Legible Graffiti fix-A-flat, you will need some supplies, as shown in the picture.



A fun alphabet like the one shown above, can be used to draw your name, or a friend's name in 3D.
