BOOKS SENT FOR CONSERVATION

- **Property Redemption Ledger 1897-1905**
 - Land purchases by citizens, include description, lot, block, amount, value, tax, and name of purchaser.
- **Sales Tax Register 1914-1923**
 - East San Diego register of sales tax. Additions, blocks, lots, assessment, tax for lighting and water, names of early citizens, and addresses.
- **Delinquent Tax 1872-1904**
 - Additions to Old Town and the lots sold (with year and certificate page number). Includes blocks to Morse and Whaley Addition, Northern Extension of Horton's Addition, Ocean Beach, Pueblo Lands, Park Villas, Pacific Beach, Roseville, and San Diego New Town and Old Town, Sorrento, and University Heights
- **Index Book A-L (Undated)**
 - Index of citizen's names A-L with reference to another book (unknown). Includes list of banks and churches.
- **Water Mains, Gates, Fire Hydrants and Sewer Flush Caps 1909-1923**
 - Water mains laid with location, length and size of pipe, gates set and removed, fire hydrants installed and removed, and sewer flush tank taps installed.

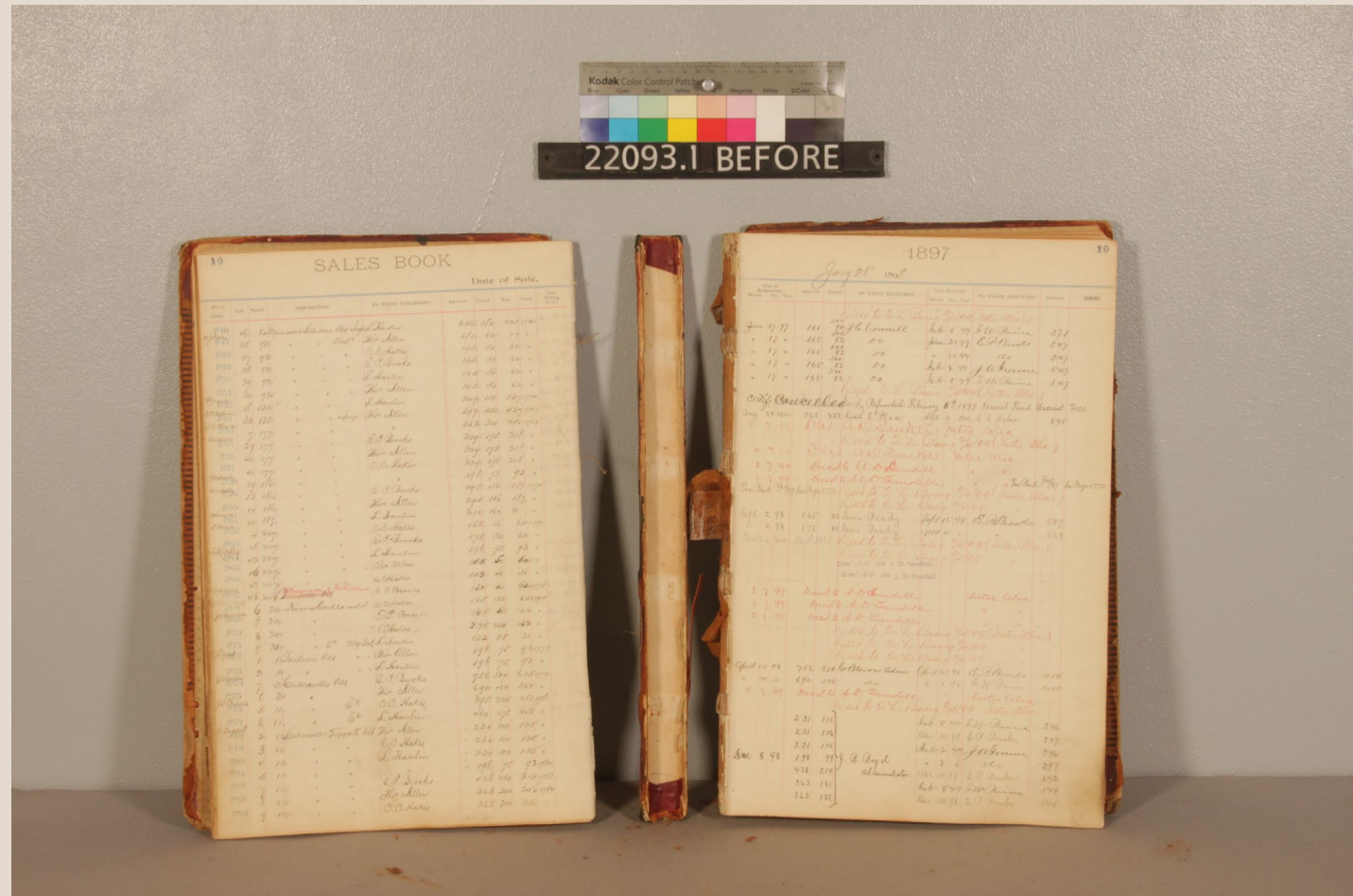
The Process

- Fully unbind the text
- Remove linen tape from front/rear gutters
- Surface clean leaves with non-aqueously deacidify
- Repair/guard as needed
- Sewing on acid-free endpapers
- Dismount front pastedown/document
- Re-attach manuscript leaf
- Resew text
- Insert dedicatory pages inside front cover
- Rebind in cloth, with spine and front lettering in gold

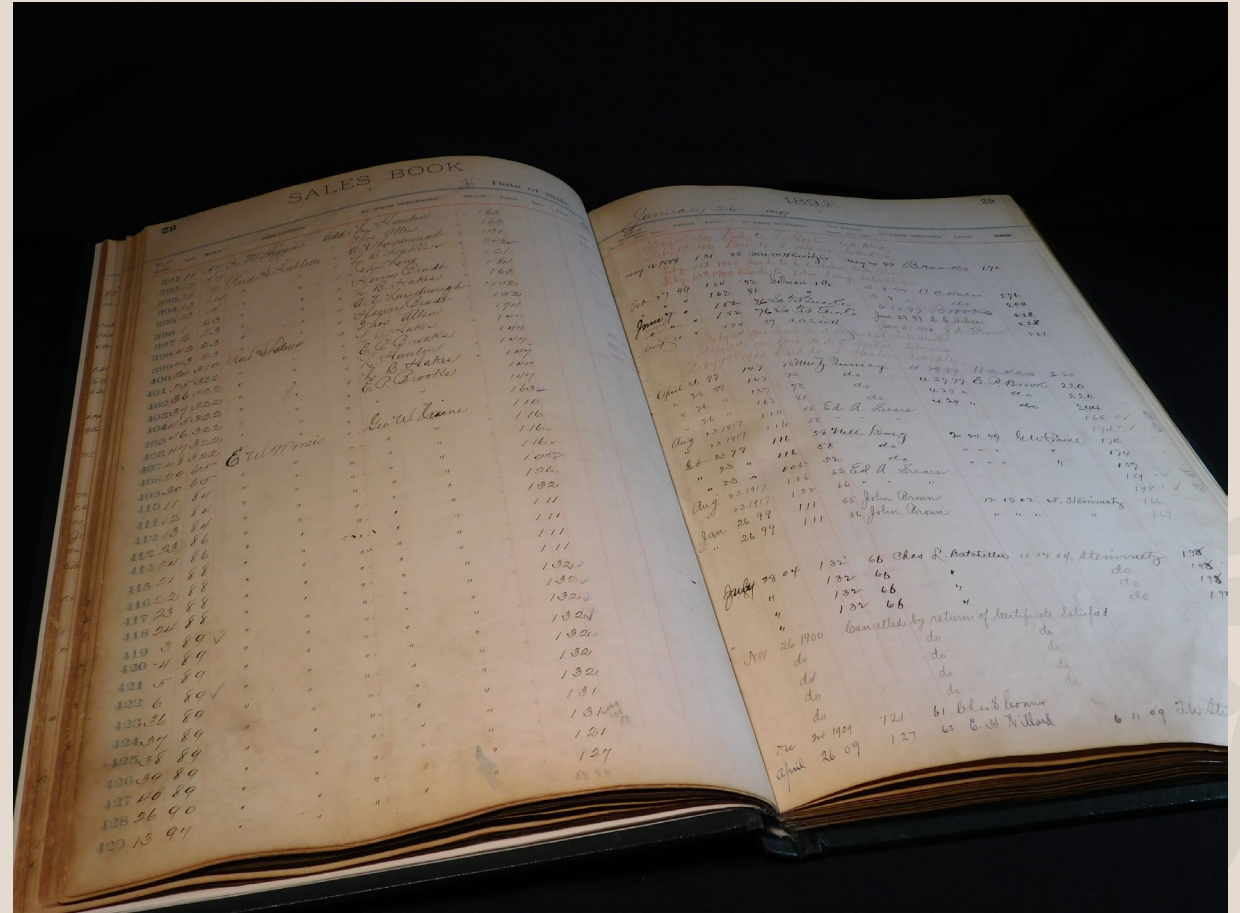
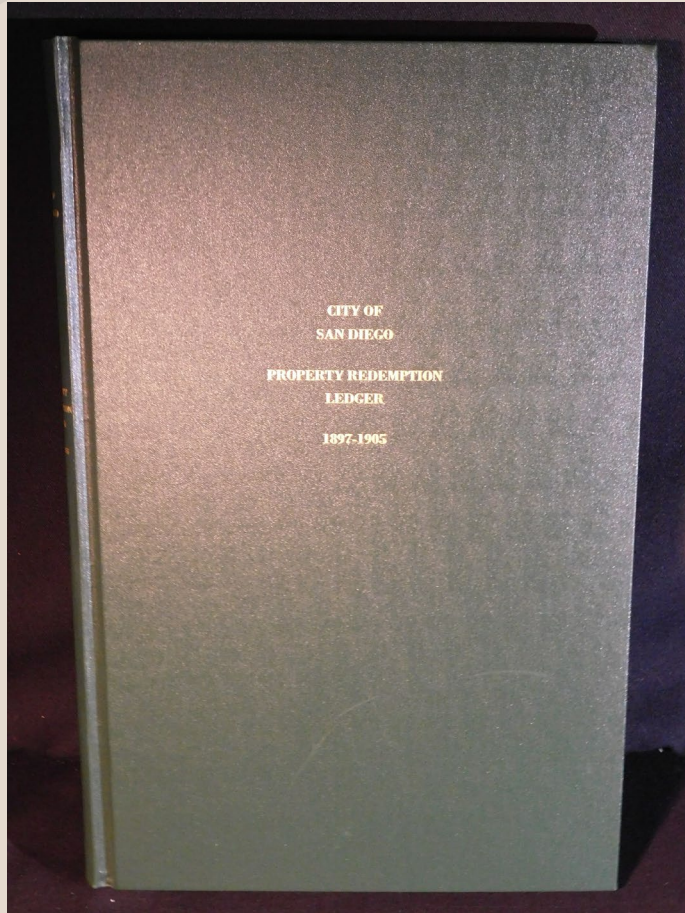


Property Redemption Ledger (1897-1905)

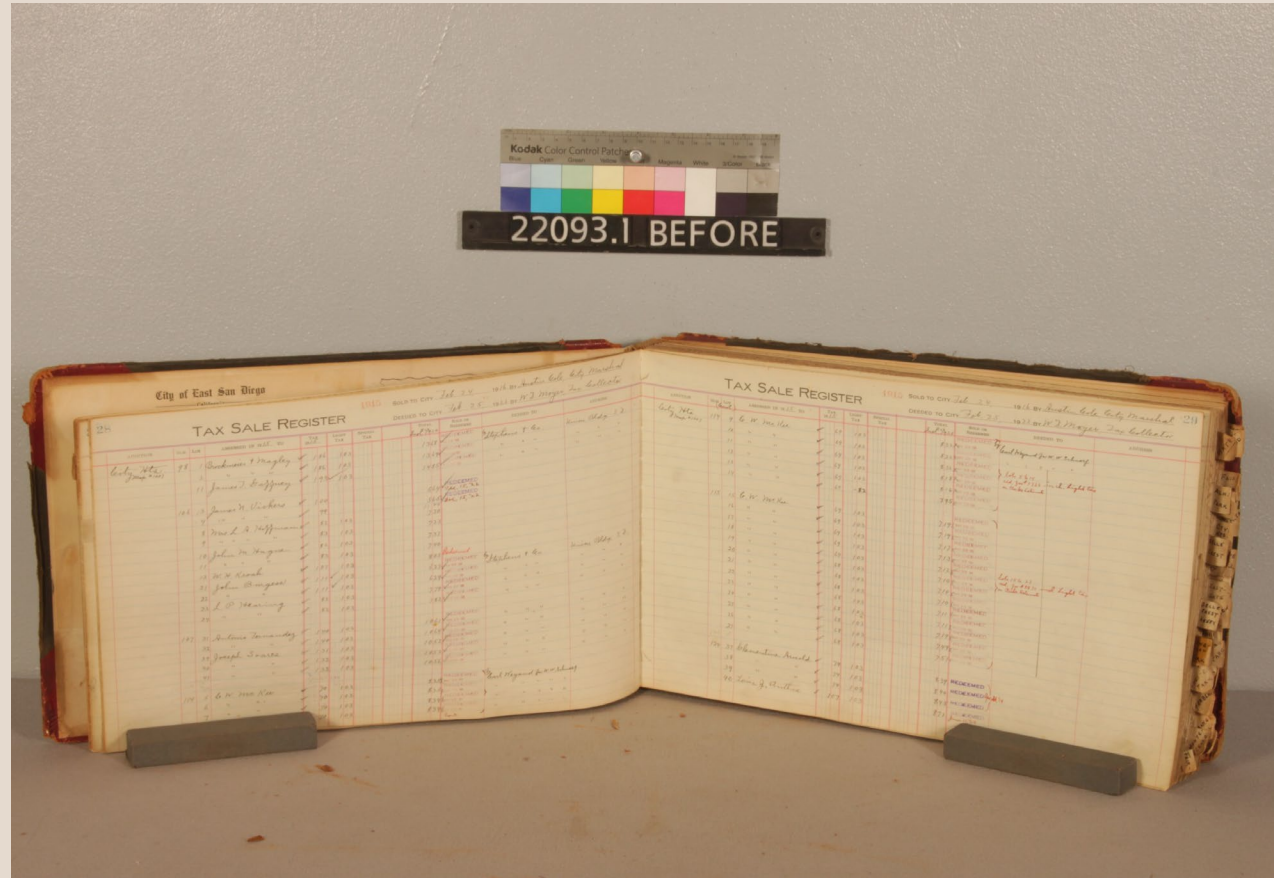
