Family history-Adoptions-Medical

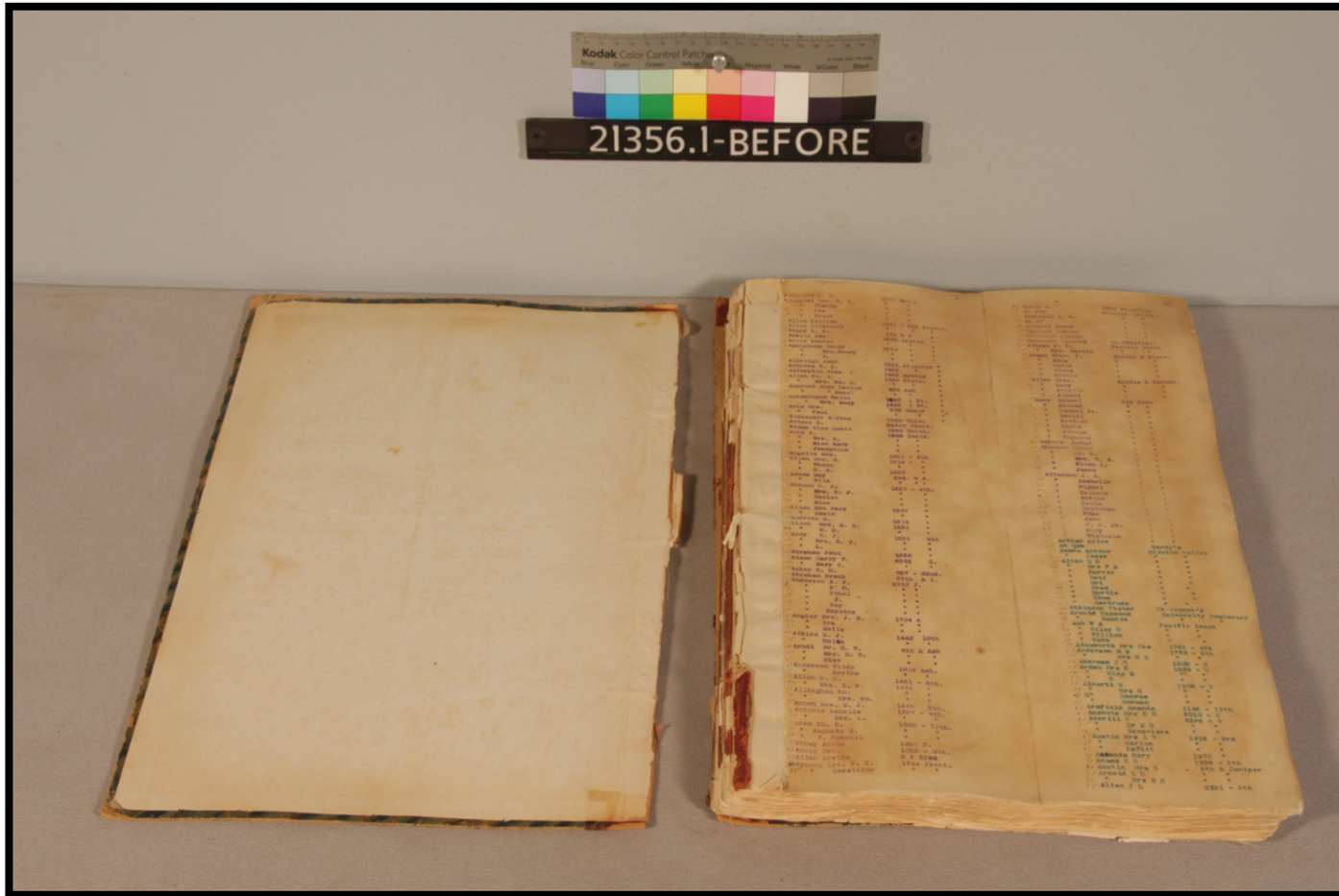

 - Destroyed in 1921

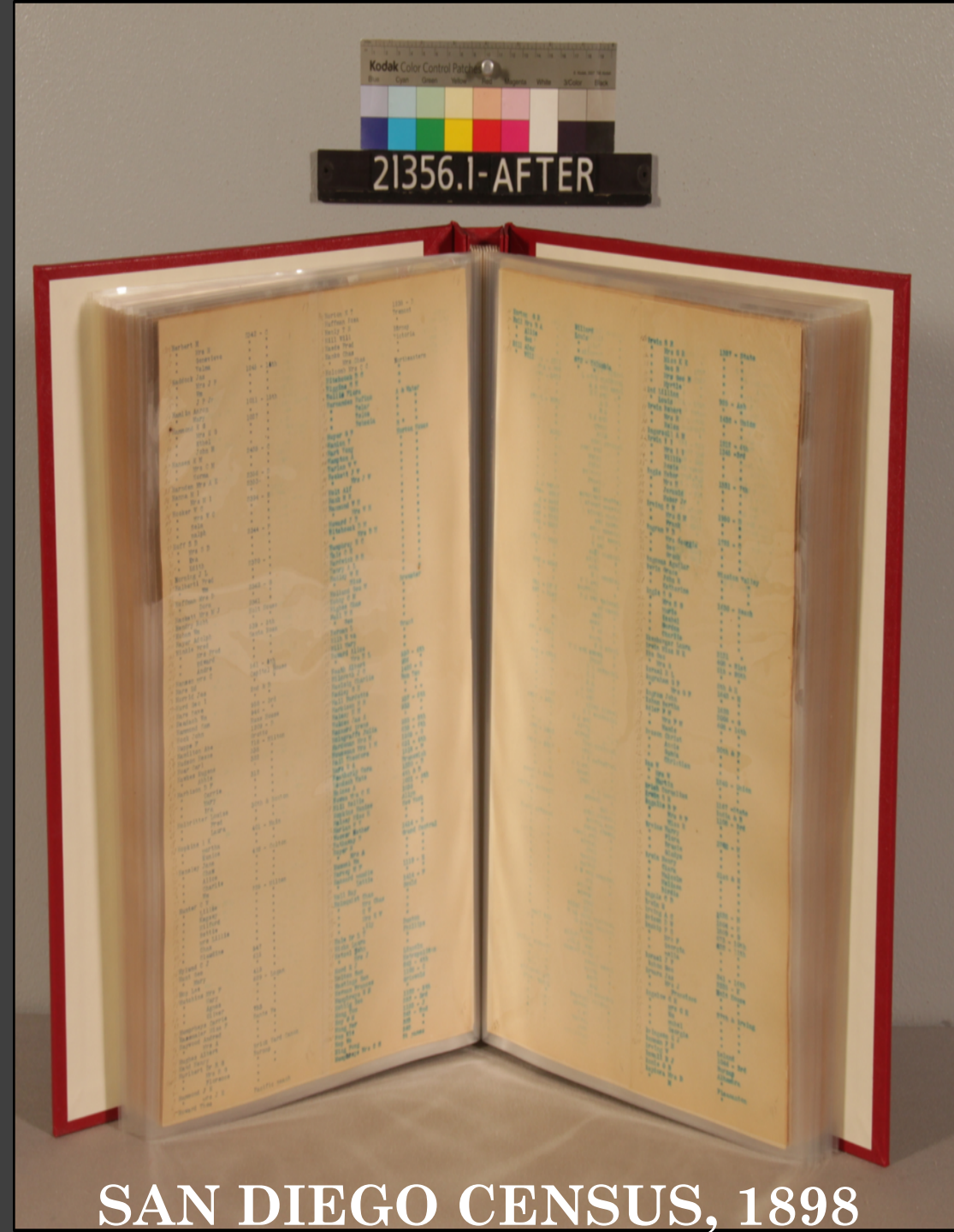

After Elevated Preservation:

- Surface cleaning with latex sponge and soft brush
- Non-aqueous
- Magnesium oxide used for deacidification
- Paper mended utilizing 13gm Tengu-jo (Japanese paper with deckled edges) and starch paste
- Pages humidified and flattened prior to insertion into Mylar sleeves
- Rebound with book-cloth, post binding (no penetration of pages)
- Gold foil lettering and acid-free end sheets
