Item-1: Call to Order

Chairman Cabrera called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Item-5: Commissioner Comment

Chairman Cabrera reported that there was concern expressed by several City Councilmembers during a recent meeting of the Rules Committee that the level of

the Commission's fines may discourage individuals from running for public office. He related that he explained to the Councilmembers that the Commission uses the fines issued by the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) as guidelines as well as many other factors when determining fines. He added that Councilmember Madaffer indicated that the Commission's focus should be on education to prevent future enforcement actions. Chairman Cabrera reported that he advised the Rules Committee that the Commission has a very responsive and active education program.

Item-6: Executive Director Comment

Director Fulhorst thanked Chairman Cabrera for making time during the last several weeks to appear before the City Council for numerous Commission presentations as well as making himself available to the media. She noted that it was important for the Commission Chair to represent the Commission before the City Council and with the media, because it indicates that Commissioners are involved and participating in Commission matters.

Item-7: General Counsel Comment

Ms. Adema commented on updates that were made by staff to a fact sheet concerning acceptance of tickets and invitations. She advised that the updates reflect recent changes made to the Fair Political Practices Commission's regulations on tickets and invitations to political fundraisers and 501(c)(3) fundraisers. She noted that the new rules will only exempt one ticket per event from the gift laws. She added that the tickets need to be received directly from the 501(c)(3) or the political committee, and not from a third party.

Item-8: Proposed Amendments to Municipal Lobbying Ordinance

Director Fulhorst reported that the City Council Rules Committee unanimously approved the Commission's recommended changes to the Lobbying Ordinance and forwarded them on to the full City Council. She noted that representatives from the Labor Council and Chamber of Commerce attended the Committee meeting and spoke in favor of the changes.

Item-9: Presentation of Final Audit Report Regarding the Audit of the Donna Frye for Mayor 2005 Committee

Commission Auditor Rosalba Gomez presented the report and noted that there were no material findings.
