Case No. 2010-42 – Alleged Failure to Timely Amend Registration Forms

After stating for the record that they each personally heard or read the testimony and reviewed the evidence from the probable cause hearing, the Commissioners determined that there is probable cause to believe that the respondent may have violated a governmental ethics law and that the matter shall be heard at a public administrative hearing.

A summary of the allegations is as follows: The Commission found that probable cause exists as to 9 counts of violating the City's campaign laws specifically relating to the filing of campaign statements, the disclosure of campaign expenditures, the maintaining of campaign records, and the acceptance of contributions from non-individuals.

The Commission noted that the Respondent is presumed to be innocent unless and until such time that the allegations are proven to be a violation at the administrative hearing.

Motion:

In connection with its probable cause determination, the Commission has authorized the issuance of a Final Administrative Complaint and directed the Executive Director to schedule an administrative hearing within 120 days.
