Item 8: Presentation by Clerk regarding Proposed Amendments to Lobbying Laws

City Clerk Elizabeth Maland explained that the Municipal Lobbying Ordinance was amended in 2008 to provide for the electronic filing of registration forms and disclosure reports as soon as it was practical and financially feasible. Ms. Maland reported that her office offered voluntary electronic filling at the beginning of the year, and recently made electronic filling mandatory. As a result, she would like to eliminate the duplicative paper filing requirement. She assured the Commission that the transition would not interfere with the Commission's ability to enforce late or incomplete lobbyist fillings because her office will be able to determine with certainty what documents were electronically filed and when.

Elections Analyst Denise Jenkins presented a chronology related to the development of the online filing system as reflected in a PowerPoint presentation.

Ms. Maland asked the Commission to support the elimination of paper filing, and to include this proposed amendment with the other recommended changes to the campaign and lobbying laws that will be heard by the City Council on October 22, 2012.
