San Diego Pride

My team and I had a wonderful time marching in this year's Pride Parade.

For the first time ever, the San Diego City Council marched as a whole, demonstrating our commitment to the rights of our LGBTQ+ community.

Nearly 1,100 capital improvement projects valued at \$5.2 billion moved through the City's construction process in Fiscal Year 2023. Among the department's noteworthy achievements, construction contracts were awarded for 142 projects with a value of \$792.6 million, including **Street Reconstruction Group 1801** in Mira Mesa making improvements along Gold Coast Dr and Parkdale Ave.
