NEM 2.0

- Grandfathering of systems into NEM 1.0 – 20 year beginning with the year the system was interconnected
- Draft Public Tool – evaluate the costs and benefits of any alternate NEM rate structure. Parties description of Public Tool:
 - Complex
 - Difficult to understand
 - Time consuming to run
 - Limited in functionality
- Reservation Queueing System – Motion introduced by CALSEIA to ensure a smooth transition to the NEM 2.0 successor tariff:
 - Allows for transparency into which rate schedule customers will take service under

NEM 2.0: What's Next

- Finalize Residential Rate Reform Proceeding to feed results into the Public Tool
- Reservation Queuing System Decision by CPUC
- Final Decision 12/31/15

Residential Rate Reform

- Proposed Decision released 4/21/15
- Main thrust of PD:
 - No fixed charges for 5 years
 - Flatter tiers: 2 tiers with 20% differential
 - Glide path of 5 years for tier flattening and then implementation of fixed charge
 - TOU rates will now be default with Tiered rates as the option
 - Question: how can sustainable technologies continue to grow?
