Improvements in Mira Mesa and University City

The City's Department of Transportation operations teams made significant upgrades to the intersection of Mira Mesa Boulevard and Reagan Road in Mira Mesa. The safety improvements included traffic signal replacement, traffic signal timing modifications, changes to crosswalks and stop limit lines, and pedestrian push-button installs. The work took place during evening hours due to the high volume of traffic at this busy intersection. This was a complex upgrade that will make this intersection safer for both vehicles and pedestrians.

This week, City Council approved \$750k for Marcy Park in University City, filling the final gap in total funding needs to move the project towards construction. This approval is a crucial and exciting step and I look forward to seeing the benefits a newly improved Marcy Park will bring to University City families!



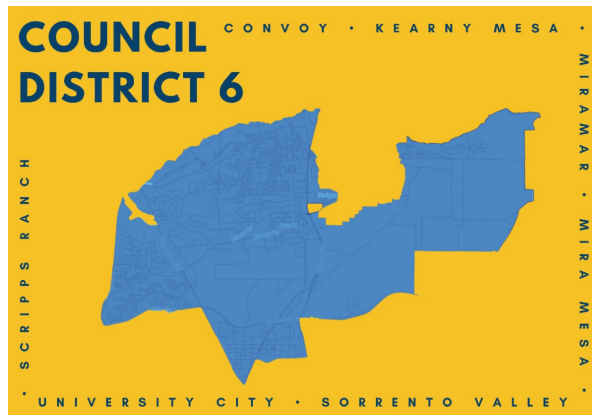
