Background

Budget Priorities Resolution is Council's first step in the budget process

- Budget Priorities Resolutions are initially prepared in September/October.
- Priorities Updates are determined February.
- New step: 1¢ TOT recommended allocation
 - B&GE to consider ED&IR recommendation
- Budget Priorities Resolution will be submitted to Mayor after approval by City Council.



Background

Budget Priorities Resolution is Council's first step in the budget process (con't)

- Updates to FY 2025 Councilmembers' priorities submitted to our Office on January 12, 2024.
 - IBA Report 24-02 summarizes updated budget priorities.
 - Besides majority supported priorities, priorities that received support from four Councilmembers are also highlighted.
 - Not part of the Budget Priorities Resolution unless Council designates them as such.



Background

Budget Priorities Resolution is Council's first step in the budget process (con't)

- On January 10, 2024, ED&IR forwarded a recommendation for the proposed allocation of the 1¢ TOT to the B&GE Committee for consideration:
 - 6.5% of total TOT revenue (estimated \$21.5M) for Arts, Culture, and Community Festivals
 - Remaining amount (estimated \$10.0M) to help balance the General Fund budget
