

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Must be 16 or older
- 2. Must complete a background check
- 3. Must complete at least 4 hours of
- community service (or the minimum required by your school for graduation)

4. For volunteers under the age of 18 we require a letter of recommendation from a non-family member and registered as a student

What you need to apply to become a Volunteer:

- 1. Volunteer application form
- 2. Drivers license
- 3. Social security card
- 4. For volunteers under the age of 18, a school ID is required.
