- 10. Action Item: Project Number 646279 California American Water Highland Tank Pressure Relief Valve (PRV) Modernization Project. Located near the intersection of Palm Avenue and Beyer Boulevard in the City of San Diego. The Highland Tank PRV station is located immediately adjacent to an existing 3 million gallon above ground steel distribution storage tank built in 1963.

**Background:** California American Water intends to install a micro-hydroelectric turbine generator (HTG) unit at the Highland Tank pressure reducing valve (PRV) station that includes a pressure management system, a control module, and a SCADA system remote terminal unit for data collection and analysis.
