Victim Identified in Shooting Death of Male in Oak Park

San Diego – On March 28, 2024, at approximately 10:54 p.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a call reporting a single vehicle accident at the intersection of 60th Street and Michael Street in the Oak Park neighborhood of San Diego. Officers from Southeastern Division and personnel from the San Diego Fire-Rescue Department were dispatched immediately and arrived within minutes. Upon arriving, they found a vehicle along the west curb line that had crashed into a fence and an unresponsive male in the driver's seat. Upon removing the male from the vehicle, it was determined the male was suffering from a single gunshot wound to his upper body. Paramedics performed life saving measures at the scene before the male was transported to a local hospital. Unfortunately, despite the best efforts of medical personnel, the male was pronounced deceased at 11:42 p.m.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and are currently investigating the incident. It is still early in the investigation but Detectives have learned the victim was possibly involved in some type of verbal altercation with two other males in the nearby area. During that altercation the victim was shot prior to driving his vehicle a short distance before crashing at the intersection of 60th Street and Michael Street. The suspect(s) in this case are described as being possibly Hispanic males. Homicide detectives are in the process of attempting to locate any witnesses, surveillance video or physical evidence that may assist in solving this case.

The victim has been identified as Andres Dominguez of Poway. He is described as a 25-year-old Hispanic male.
