INSPIRATION POINT SOLAR PROJECT

February 4, 2016



Background

- In 2014, the City completed a “Solar Assessment” of over 200 City facilities, including
 - Libraries, Pools and Rec. Centers
 - Police & Fire Dept. assets
 - Admin and General Operations activities
- Assessment looked at buildings and parking lots.
- Electrical loading was a critical consideration.
- Study identified approx. 100 locations where solar photovoltaic systems can be installed.
- 1± megawatts of solar generation.



Schedule

- Start construction Summer 2016
- Finish construction Winter 2016
- 3rd party provider through a Power Purchase Agreement.
- Solar can save more than **\$1M/year** in energy costs.
- Solar canopies will provide shade and additional improved lighting.
- Installation of Solar will help the City achieve its Climate Action Plan and sustainability goals.

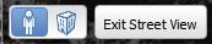
