Disability and Employment Awareness Month

WHEREAS, National Disability Employment Awareness Month originated in 1945 with a declaration from the United States Congress; and

WHEREAS, Disability and Employment Awareness Month celebrates the contributions of America's workers with disabilities past and present and showcases supportive, inclusive employment policies, and practices that benefit employers and employees; and

WHEREAS, Disability and Employment Awareness Month serves as an important reminder of the positive transformation in perceptions of disabilities, which was driven by the demands and advocacy of people with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, Disability and Employment Awareness highlights the challenges that people with disabilities face and why it is necessary to spread awareness to combat widespread discrimination, segregation, and exclusion on a broader scale; and

WHEREAS, Access to Independence of San Diego provides employment and critical independent living skills to people with disabilities, having served thousands across the region; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is a proud supporter of people with disabilities and strives to ensure that every facility, activity, benefit, program, service operated, or funded by the City is fully accessible to, and useable by, people with disabilities; NOW, THEREFORE
