Aids Walk/Run San Diego, Sarafina Scapicchio, The San Diego LGBT Community Center Sunday, September 29, 2013, A new event courses were established due to the expected construction activity in the Central Mesa portion of the park. The walk/run routes will take place on 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Balboa Drive and University Avenue between 6<sup>th</sup> Ave. and Park Blvd. The festival site remains the same between El Prado and Quince St. A new element is being requested, a “Street Challenge” Obstacle Course along the route is being proposed with six stations. At the conclusion of the run, groups of participants will be released to go from obstacle to obstacle to complete the challenge.

Staff Recommendation: To approve the new routes and the “Street Challenge” with an understanding that staff will further review the exact placement of obstacles, as more information becomes available, to prevent turf damage in heavily used park areas.

Saturday February 22, 2014: A new event proposal for the 6<sup>th</sup> and El Prado south lawn from 7:00 A.M. – 2:00 P.M. Balboa Dr. south of El Prado will be closed. A procession at 8:30 A.M. is planned starting at Balboa Drive and Juniper St., heading south on 6<sup>th</sup> Ave., west on Broadway, north on 1<sup>st</sup> Ave., east on Kalmia St. concluding in Balboa Park. A celebration will be held in the park from 10:30 A.M. – 2:00 P.M. with amplified sound and vendors. Participants will be shuttled to the park. Estimated attendance is 5,000.
