Event Narrative for the 2015 Philippine American Celebration(2015 P.A.C.)

Dates of main events: June 5th through June 7th 2015 in Balboa Park.

Who are the members of the 2015 P.A.C.: Council Of Philippine American Organizations(C.O.P.A.O.), DOD FED GLOBE, Fil-Am Fest, Gawad Kalinga, House of the Philippines, Operation Samahan, PASAC, PASACAT, Samahan Filipino American Performing Arts & Education Center, Silayan Filipina National Organization, are a legally constituted nonprofit corporations or business under the laws of the State of California, and want to present a world class celebration of Philippine arts & culture, history, innovation and commerce. The 2015 P.A.C. will draw visitors to San Diego while engaging community participation and exchanges to appeal an audience of local San Diegans as well. Based on the combined community festivals that all members of the 2015 P.A.C. according to the economic impacts to the region from their current City & County of San Diego awarded grants increases the estimated impact to the Greater San Diego Region up to one million dollars.

With the participation of the Samahan Filipino American Performing Arts & Education Center; they have successfully maintained a 30 year tradition of its celebration in Balboa Park that is the basis for this one time 2015 special event collaboration. In 2016; the Samahan Filipino American Performing Arts & Education Center will continue its celebration on their own again back to its similar plans in the month of August. (The 2015 proposal maintains the duration in the Moratorium)

Impacts to Balboa Park

- Use of the public spaces in the park starting on non-holiday week-end on Thursday, June 4th will be a light impact upon the initial drop of canopies, booth frames, decorations, electronic cables, setting for lights.
- There are no road closures for the 2015 P.A.C.. Hence, the event will not block road access for the general public.
- Permitting the outdoor uses that allows the 2015 P.A.C. to place 12 recycling & 12 more trash containers in the outdoors, of which will be emptied daily by the Alpha Project Representatives. Hiring the Alpha Project representatives for this task provides assistance to another 501(c)(3)/non-profit to help keep the park clean on a regular basis.
- Permitting portable sinks allows the food vendors to maintain good food practices that maintains the safety standards for foods to be prepared prior to sell and sanitary cleaning the food preparing areas.
- Amplified sound is requested for the performances of the Samahan Filipino American Performing Arts & Education Center & the PASACAT Dance Troupe. However, the music frivolity will add to Balboa Park's festive atmosphere. The sound decibels will not drown-out the passing tourism. Both performing troupes have Rondallion Groups(string instruments) that need amplification to allow their sound to carry & be heard by the folk dance performers.
- Permitting the hired security personnel to keep the grounds safe from damage and left, although a requirement for the beer garden and for the large gathering crowds; provide a presence of protection for out of town visitors exploring the park for the first time.
