 - Pan American Road West (whole road) between Pan American Road East and Pan American Plaza

 - Small lot south of Aerospace Museum (access from President's Way)
 - Lot south of Hall of Champions (access from President's Way)

Parking Plan

- Staff/Volunteers Main starting line parking will remain the same. Some parking will be needed for on-course volunteers within the park.
- Participants shuttled from Qualcomm Stadium to the Start Line (not inside the park)

Traffic Plan

- As in prior years, Park Blvd. will be closed to southbound traffic from University Avenue through the Park to the I-5 overpass and beyond. The traffic plan below is only for the <u>new</u> section of the course on the east side of Balboa Park near the Zoo (approx. miles 2.5-4.5):
- There would be a rolling closure approximately 30 minutes before the first runner. Estimated road closure times are:
 - a. 6:15 a.m. at Park and Village Place;
 - b. 6:20 a.m. for El Prado;
 - c. 6:20 a.m. for Pan American Road West and East;
 - d. 6:25 a.m. for President's Way.
- These roads would reopen as soon as possible behind the last official runner and when all course materials were safely removed from public roadways (traffic control equipment, water station supplies, mile markers and clocks, stages and generators, etc.). Estimated road reopening times are:
 - a. 8:45 a.m. at Park and Village Place;
 - b. 8:45 a.m. for El Prado;
 - c. 8:50 a.m. for Pan American Road West and East;
 - d. 9:05 a.m. for President's Way.
- This closure would be implemented by San Diego Police Department working with our traffic control supplier. Supplies would be installed as late as possible and picked up immediately following the final runner to reopen roads as soon as possible.

• San Diego Police would monitor all signaled and major intersections.

Shuttle Plan

- All participants will be shuttled from Qualcomm Stadium
- Drop off location same as in previous years
