Operation Homefront has held Freedom Walk on September 11<sup>th</sup> beginning 2006 in Balboa Park, to honor the lives lost on 9/11 as well show support for troops deployed to Iraq and Afghanistan as a result of the 9/11 attacks. This is a nationwide event held in large cities across the country. This year, emphasis will be placed on “cheering” for our troops, and letting them know, regardless of our stance on these wars, that they are in our thoughts.
