

Red Dress Run 2010 Trail

Start Civic Center Plaza

4:00 pm Persons marking trail leave Civic Center

4:15 pm All Persons following trail leave Civic Center

North on 2nd Ave

Left (West) Ash Street

Right (North) Union Street

Left (West) Date St

Right (North) India St

Right (East) Hawthorn St

Left (North) Columbia

4:30 pm Brief Stop at 2135 Columbia Street (Private Residence)

(See Attached)

4:40 pm continue North on State Street.

Right (East) on West Maple St into Canyon.

5:00 pm Emerge from Canyon at Quince St

East on Quince St

Left (North) 4th Ave

Right (East) Redwood

Brief Stop at 3100 Fifth Avenue (The Caliph)

Continue on Redwood

Right on 6th

Left (East) on Quince into Balboa Park

South through Balboa Park using pathways

5:20 pm Exit Balboa Park

South on 6th avenue

Right (West) on B Street to Civic Center

The new route written out above contains a change to avoid crossing Laurel Street. It is a simple change which I believe would cause the least impact to anyone using the park or passing through. We would simply follow the same route into the park and same south bound path, until we approach Laurel Street. Prior to Laurel Street we would follow the path down to the trail which passes under Laurel Street and then follow that trail southbound to the wooden steps which lead back up to the upper park cement path. Using this route will ensure there is no stopping of traffic on Laurel Street.

Proposed route specifically affecting Balboa Park:

22 May 2010 approximately 5pm to 7pm

Cross over 6th avenue enter into Balboa Park at Quince Street

Proceed South on walkway, until reaching pathway which leads down to Equestrian trail.

Follow the dirt trail south bound passing under Laurel Street (El Prado) overpass.

On South side of Overpass continue on dirt path until reaching wood steps which lead back up to upper park cement walkway.

Continue South on Pedestrian trail until reaching restroom facility at south end of park.

Continue on Grass embankment heading south to west direction exiting park onto 6th avenue.
