301. <u>Finish Chelsea's Run</u> – Leisha Battles, In Motion Inc. on behalf of the Chelsea's Light Foundation Request approval to conduct a 5K Run/walk and expo to raise awareness and funds for Chelsea's Light Foundation. The 5K course proposed would impact 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Balboa Drive, El Prado, Pan American Rd, Park Blvd, North SR 163 and the Quince St. off-ramp. The expo would be conducted on the North Lawn at 6<sup>th</sup> and Laurel St. to Quince. The estimated attendance is 4,000. It is estimated that the Park roads should be clear and re-opened by 9:30 A.M. This date has recently become available due to the withdrawal of the applications for the Union-Tribune Kids Magic Mile and the Union-Tribune Race for Literacy 8K.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: To approve the event based on the following: This proposed one day event would take the place of a larger two day event, the Union Tribune Kids Magic Mile (4,000 participants) and the Race for Literacy (4,000 participants) of which In Motion Inc. had the legal rights to. Finish Chelsea's Run will have half the number of attendees of the Race for Literacy. The run/walk will start by 7:30 A.M., and all Park roads should be open by 9:30 A.M., therefore having less impact to the park users, park neighbors and Park institutions. It is recommended that this be considered a one -time event only to mark the one year anniversary of the loss of Chelsea King. Staff also recommends that Park Ranger staff be assigned at the cost of the organizer to ensure real time road opening coordination and signage removal.
