- Ms. Daniele Laman, liaison for House of Pacific Relations (HPR), reported the following:

 - International Cottages will be at the County Fair June 20, 2015 from 10:00 a.m. 5:00 p.m.

CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT

- Chairperson Kinney reported the following:
 - General Cardenas' plaque was approved unanimously at the Park and Recreation Board meeting.
 - Park and Recreation Board heard from City staff about efforts to streamline the CIP process without minimizing community input. This approach seems to be receiving a good deal of support.
 - The Maker Faire press conference will be held on June 15, 2015 at 11:00 a.m.
 - The Balboa Park Conservancy and Balboa Park Cultural Partnership will have a presence at the Fair.
 - A total of six members plan to attend the BPC meeting on Thursday, July 2, 2015.

STAFF REPORT

City Council Third District, Councilmember Todd Gloria

- Infrastructure Committee received the Facilities Assessment Report that identified the conditions of all the City's buildings that are owned and leased out. The report is available on the City's website.
- City Council passed the first ever Parklets Policy for the City of San Diego.
- Councilmember Gloria dedicated funding for the restoration of the equestrian statue of El Charro in Presidio Park.

Susan Lowery-Mendoza, District Manager, Balboa Park Facilities and Special Events

- 1. Free Twilight Concerts in the Park begin June 16, 2015 every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday night at 6:30 p.m. in the Organ Pavilion.
- 2. The elevator modernization projects are ongoing. The replacement of the Casa Del Prado elevator will begin July-August 2015.
- 3. Hall of Nations The foundation and restrooms are near completion and issues with the false ceiling will then be addressed. The estimated completion date is July 2015.
- 4. The 9/11 Heroes Event has been accommodated at the Marston Point Parking Lot. The route will loop twice around Marston Loop and come no further north than Redwood Circle and there will be no impacts to the Cabrillo Bridge. The event has been scheduled for September 13, 2015.
- 5. Park Equivalency Update:
 - An update of the Uptown, Golden Hill and North Park Community Plan will be presented as an Information Item at the June 18, 2015 Park and Recreation Board Meeting. As part of the presentation, the park equivalencies identified for each neighborhood will be discussed.
 - The recommended recreational elements within the Balboa Park East Mesa Precise Plan for Morley Field are being incorporated into the Community Plan.

Casey Smith, District Manager, Balboa Park Operations

- The balustrade project is still underway.
- Friends of Balboa Park are currently restoring the Botanical Building fountains and began working on the Cabrillo Bridge Guard Houses.
- Irrigation on the Park Boulevard medians was turned off mid-April due to the Governor's Mandate. City staff retrofitted the irrigation and installed Netafim drip rings to ensure that the trees are watered.
- Zoo Parking Lot Project Plant material on Old Globe Way was installed in April and early May.
- The City's tree service provider removed more dead and dying pines from the west mesa, including a large Canary Island Pine at the Marston House. The removed trees were impacted by bark beetles.
- City staff has been working to identify ways to reduce water usage in the park. For more information on the City's strategy to meet the 16% reduction goal, please visit the City's website at www.sandiego.gov.
- Balboa Park has two Ornamental Fountains, Bea Evenson and Plaza de Panama, which may be operated for maintenance purposes in order to preserve the fountains integrity (pumps, plumbing, grout, etc.).
- Rangers continue to work closely with SDPD, SDPD's Homeless Outreach Team and the Psychological Evaluation Response Team (PERT).

Committee Comments/Questions:

- Mr. Steppke asked why the turf areas in the Park are being watered three days a week and the residents aren't
 able to do this. Mr. Smith replied the Park is using a smart water irrigation system that allows Park and
 Recreation to dial down the irrigation system on a daily basis based on weather patterns.
- Chairperson Kinney inquired about the Cabrillo Bridge Guard Houses project. Ms. Peabody replied that the renovations will take about two to three months for completion. Chairperson Kinney further inquired about the projected opening date for Old Globe Way. Mr. Rice replied that it will open the second week of July 2015.

- The Garden Party of the Century and Floral Wagon Parade in Balboa Park was a wonderful event.
