03. PB Pathways – A Draft of Phase Two routes was completed and this will be further reviewed and developed before submitting for vote to PBPG

04. Pacific Beach Drive and Kendall St. Motion Olson/Curry: a) 4 way stop sign at Kendal and PB Drive b) Move limit line and stop sign for Southeast corner of Kendall northward to meet lane line on PB Drive c) maintain shrubbery on Eastern median so traffic stopped on southeast corner can see oncoming traffic d) better options for traffic calming such as pop outs, cross walks and reconfiguration of islands at this intersection PB Drive and Jewell will be considered in the future. Motion Passed: 3-0-0

Discussion: Rex Burns presented 33 signatures from local residents supporting the 4-way stop. The City did a study of this intersection and determined a 4 – way stop was not warranted.
