- b. EPA announced a new trash and sediment canyon collector and expand the South Bay International Wastewater Treatment Plant by 10MGD. Will reduce beach closures by 70% according to their estimates.
- c. Replacing pipeline the Hollister Street Bridge in 2022. Inquiring about resurfacing and working on drainage improvements on Hollister St, Sunset Ave, and Monument Rd at the same time.
