#### **A. SANDAG Roundabouts in University Heights (6:15-6:50pm) Action Item**

SANDAG's Georgia-Meade Bikeway Project is currently under construction. The project includes roundabouts at several intersections in the North Park Planning Committee area. There are two roundabouts (one at Meade Ave & Alabama Street, and one at Meade Ave & Louisiana Street) that are in the University Heights neighborhood, as identified in the North Park Community Plan. These two roundabouts have been completed and sandblasted with the name "North Park" as decorative elements. SANDAG submitted final design plans to the City of San Diego's Development Services Department and were approved with the decorative elements included. Residents of University Heights, including the leadership of the University Heights Community Association, are requesting these two roundabouts to be updated to read "University Heights" instead of "North Park". Community identity is important to Councilmember Ward and our office has worked with SANDAG to discuss design solutions to reflect this neighborhood identity.

Requested Action: Seek community input from NPPC on which design options are preferred for these two roundabouts. Funding for these changes will be determined by SANDAG and the Mayor's office.
