An update on the SANDAG Border to Bayshore Bikeway project that was previously presented to the OMNCPG. SANDAG approved \$240 million to fund this and other construction projects. According to the SANDAG website, the "Border to Bayshore Bikeway project is an approximately 8.5-mile route that will provide safe biking connections within and between Imperial Beach, the San Ysidro community of San Diego, and the world's busiest land border crossing at the San Ysidro Port of Entry.
