



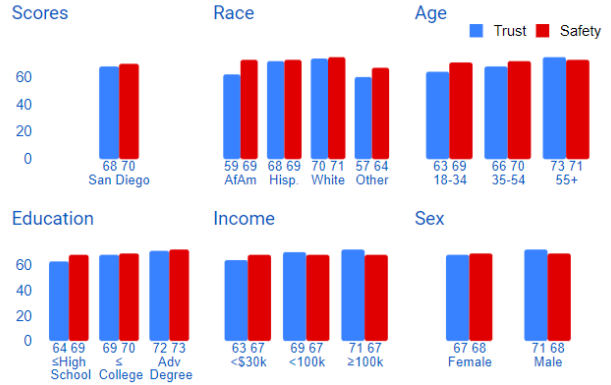

## Summary

Citywide Trust (69) was up by 1 point compared to March. Among the 9 Divisions the most significant change in Trust scores was a 4-point increase in North (71) and a 3-point increase in Mid-City (66). Citywide Safety (70) was stable without change compared to March with a 5-point drop in Western (65) and 3-point increases in Central (64) and Mid-City (69).

Citywide, the top concern was Homelessness (25%) followed by Streets & Traffic (23%) and Theft, Burglaries & Break-Ins (20%).

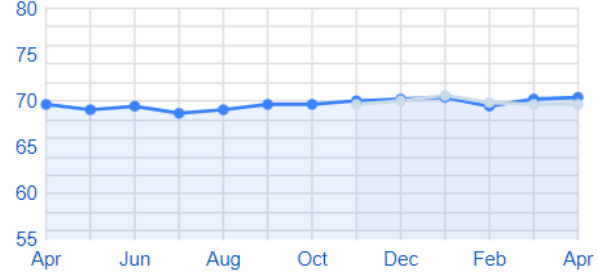
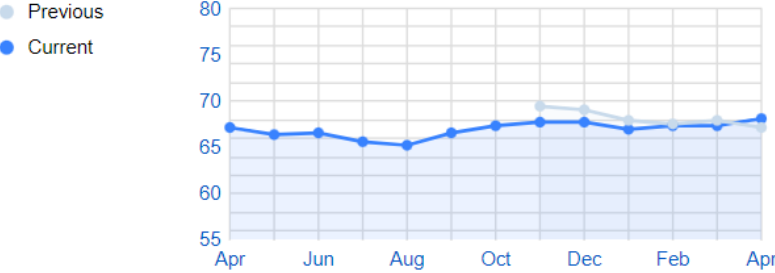

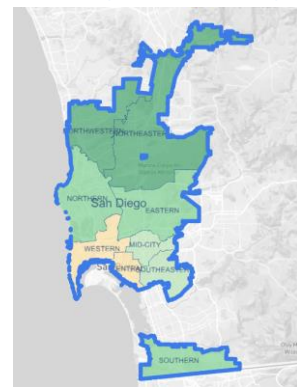

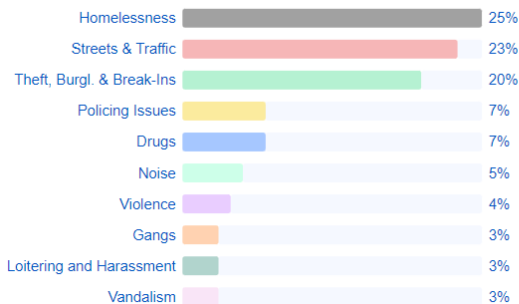
### Trust Heatmap

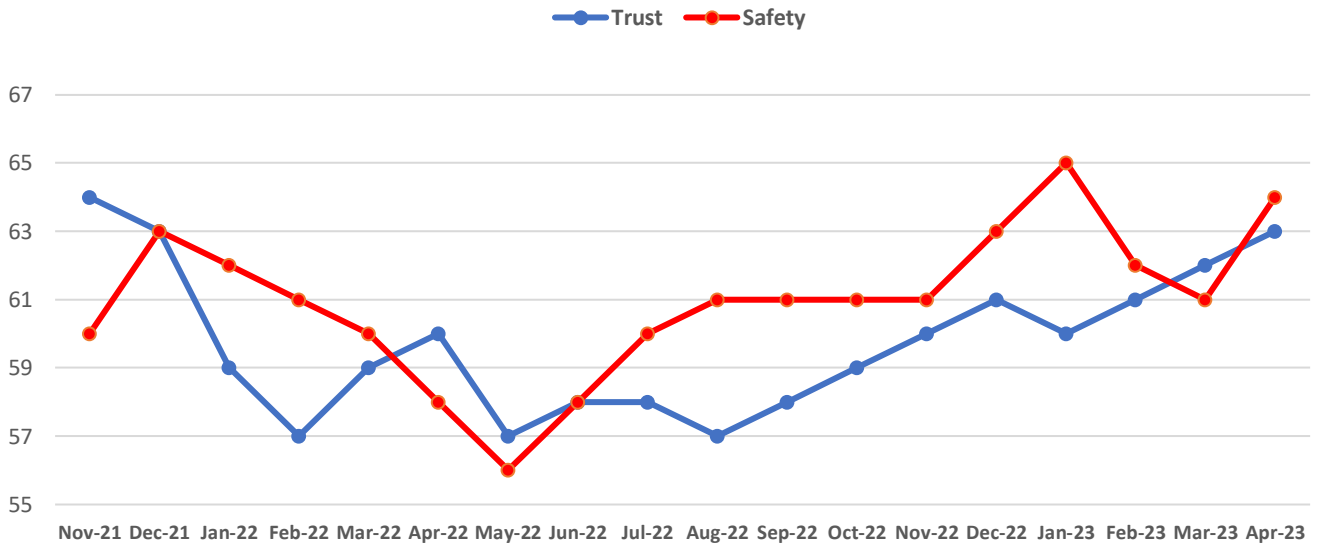
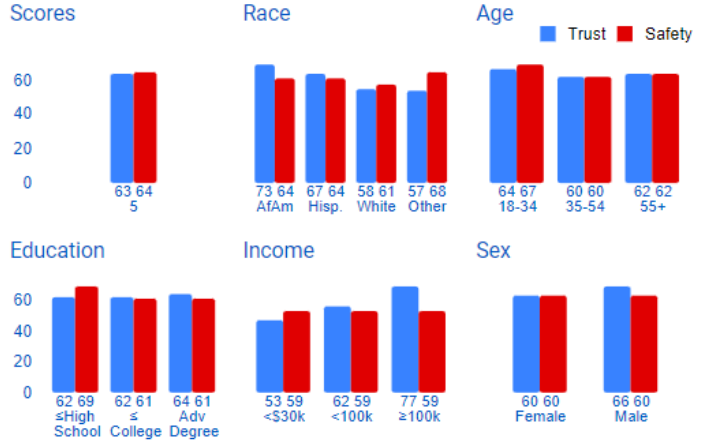

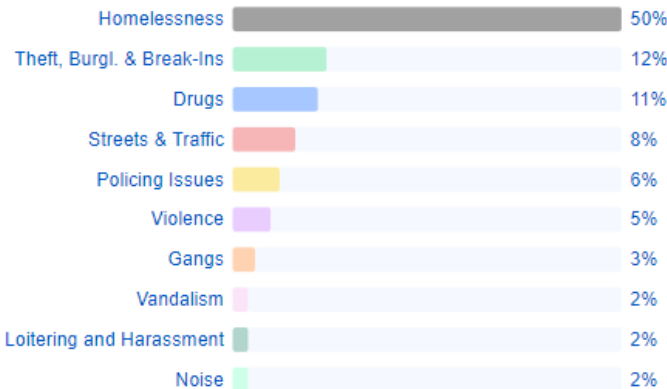
Trust for the Central Division was up by 1 point compared to the previous month (63). Safety for the Division was up by 3 points compared to the previous month (64).

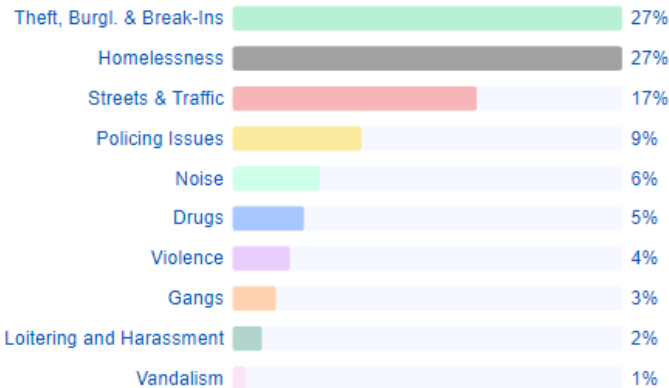
