



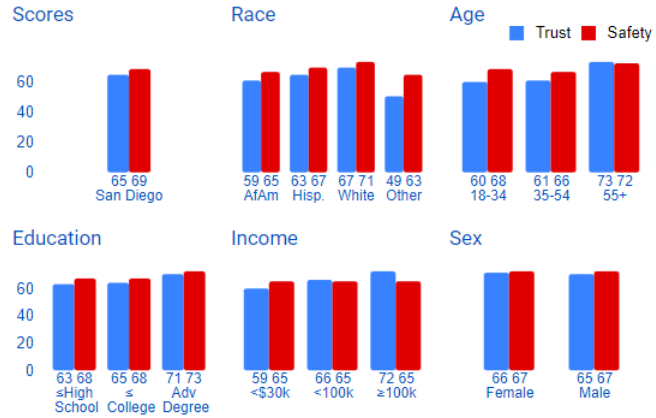

## Summary

Citywide Trust (65) was down by 1-point compared to July (marking the lowest citywide Trust score since Blockwise measurement was initiated). Among the 9 Divisions the most significant change in Trust scores was a substantial 7-point decrease in Southern (65). Citywide Safety (69) was stable without change compared to July with a 3-point increase in Northwestern (75) and 2-point increases in Eastern (75) and Southeastern (63) Safety for Southern (67) and Northern (73) dropped by 2-points.

Citywide, the top concern was Homelessness (22%) followed by Streets & Traffic (21%) and Theft, Burglaries & Break-Ins (18%).

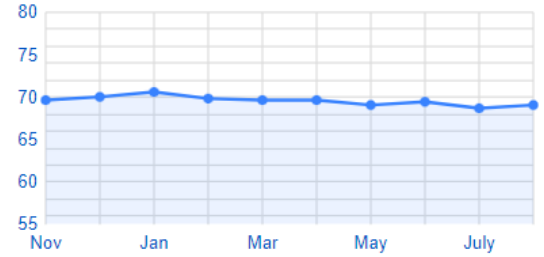
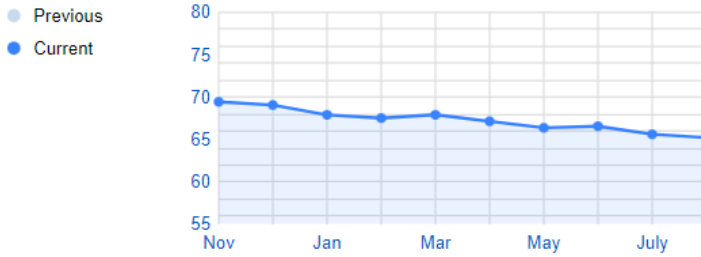

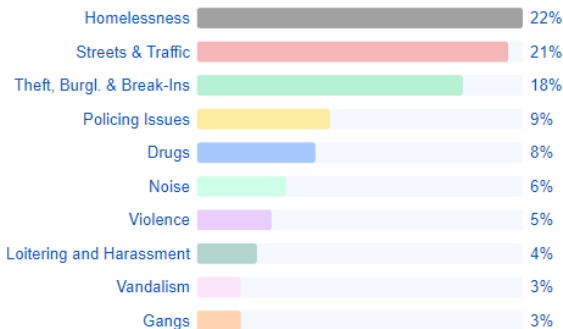
### Trust Heatmap

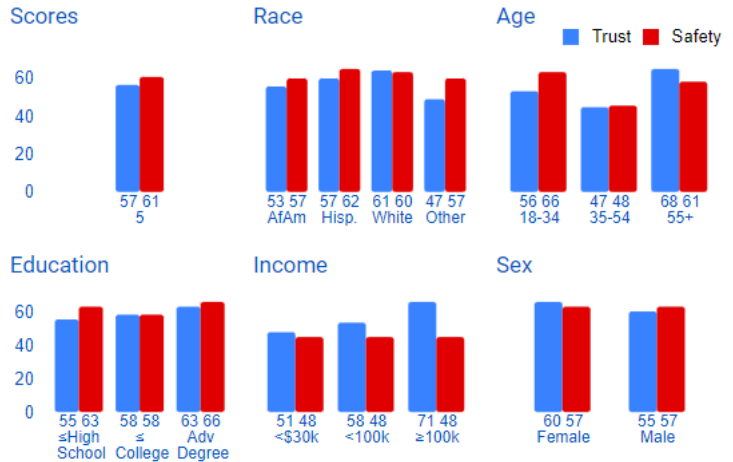

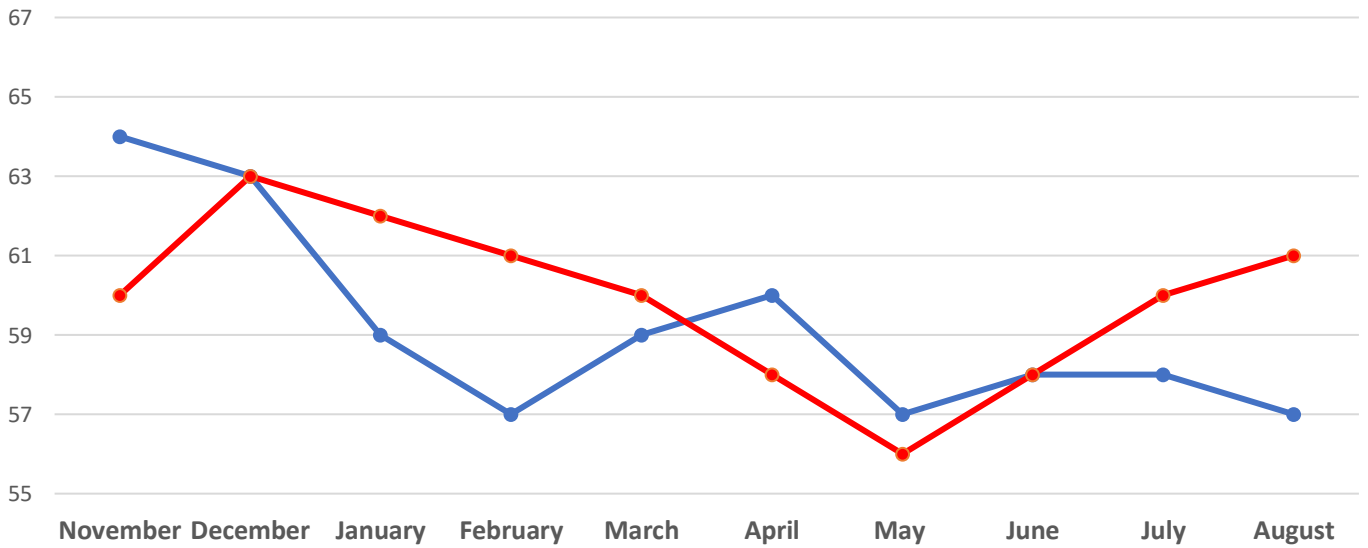
Trust for Central Division was down by 1-point compared to the previous month (57). Safety for the division was up by 1 point compared to the previous month (61).

Homelessness remained the main concern for the Division (47%), followed by Drugs (13%) and Theft, Burglaries & Break-Ins (10%).

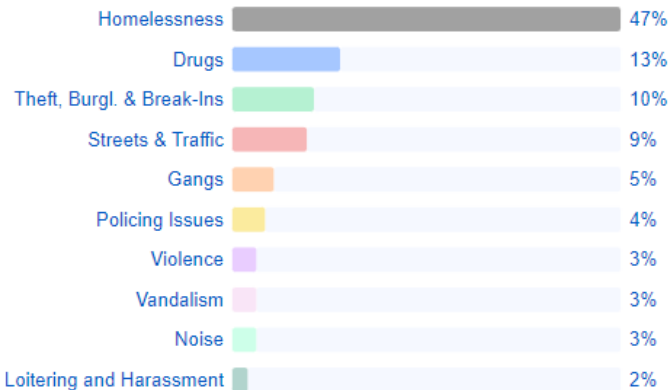
### Score Benchmark Chart
