



Summary

Citywide Trust (68) was stable and remained the same compared to January. Among the nine Divisions, the most significant changes in Trust scores were a 3-point decrease in Western (64), and a 2-point increase in Northern (73). Citywide Safety (70) was down by one point compared to January with 3-point drops for Southern (69) and Western (66).

Citywide, the top concerns were Theft, Burglaries & Break-Ins (23%) followed by Homelessness and Streets & Traffic (22% for both).






Summary




Trust for Eastern Division was stable and remained the same compared to the previous month (73). Safety for the division was also stable and remained the same compared to the previous month (74).
