



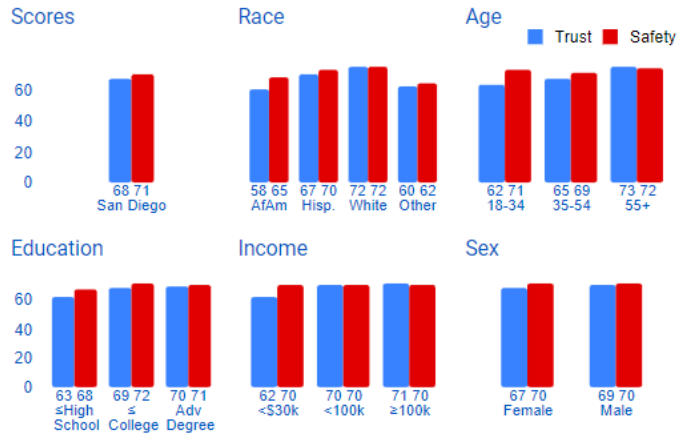

Summary

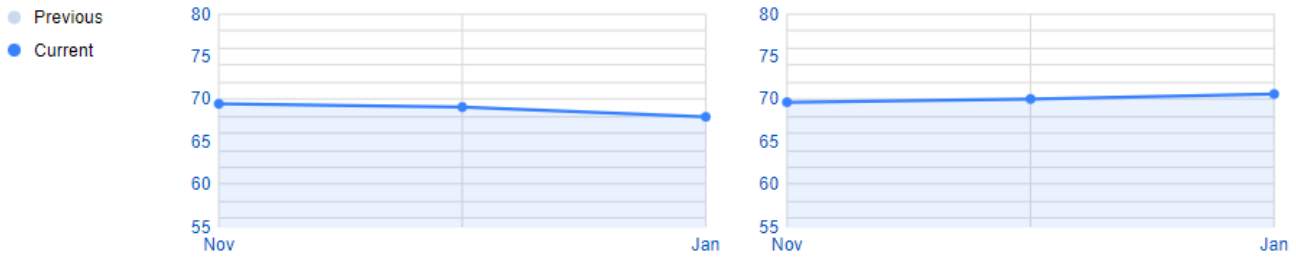
Citywide Trust (68) was down by 1 point compared to December. Among the nine divisions, the most significant changes in Trust scores were 4-point decreases in Central (59), and Northwestern (71). Citywide Safety (71) was up by one point compared to December. Safety was up by 4 points for Mid-City (68) and by 3 points for Northern (74).

Citywide the top concerns were Theft, Burglaries & Break-Ins and Streets & Traffic (22% for both) followed by Homelessness (21%).

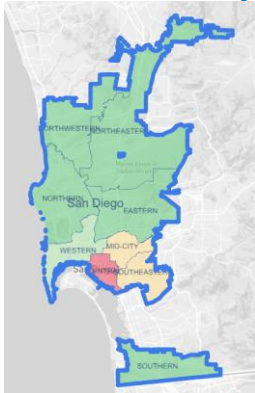
Score Benchmark Chart



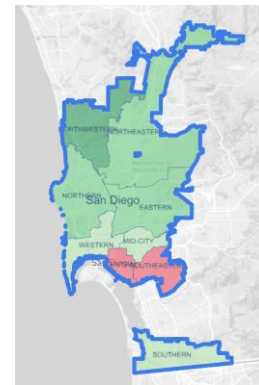
San Diego Year On Year



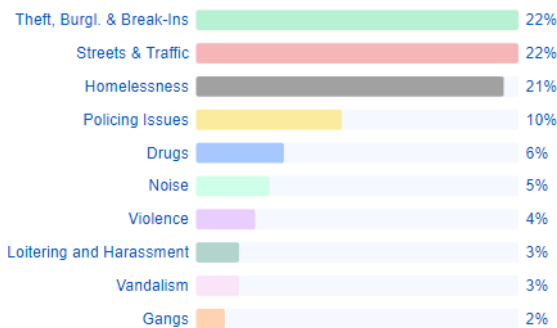
Trust Heatmap

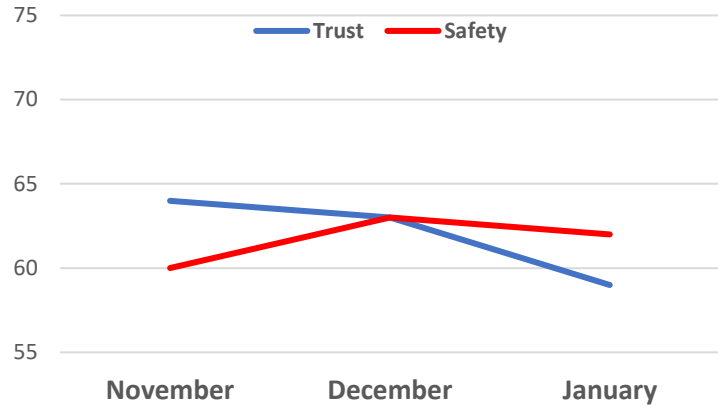

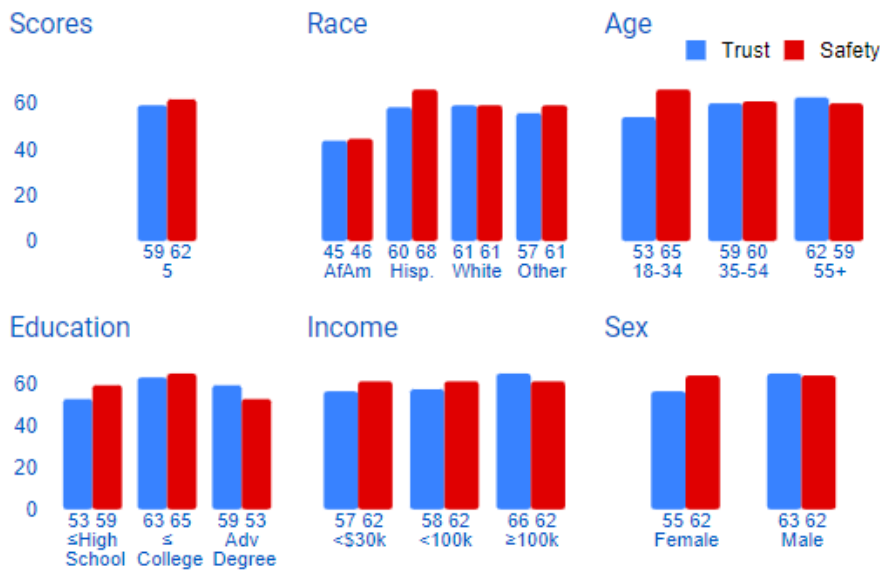

Trust for Central Division was down by 4 points compared to the previous month (59). Safety for the division was down by 1 point compared to the previous month (62).

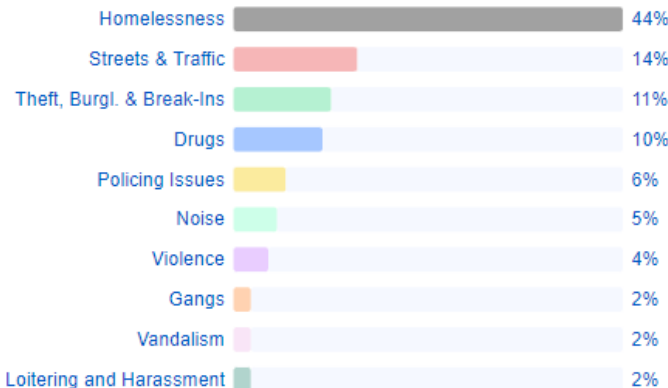

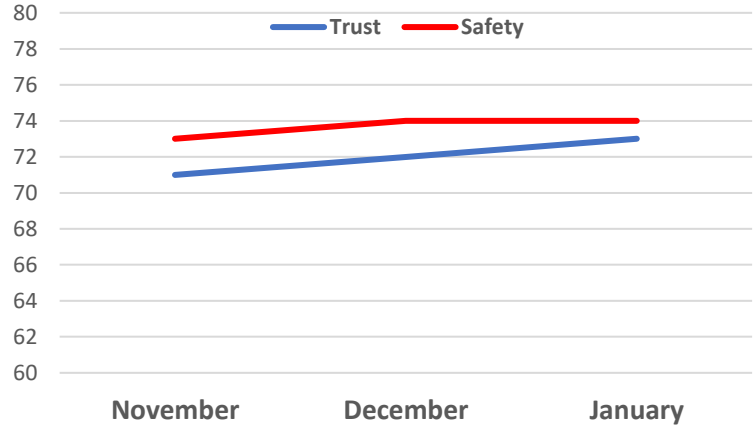

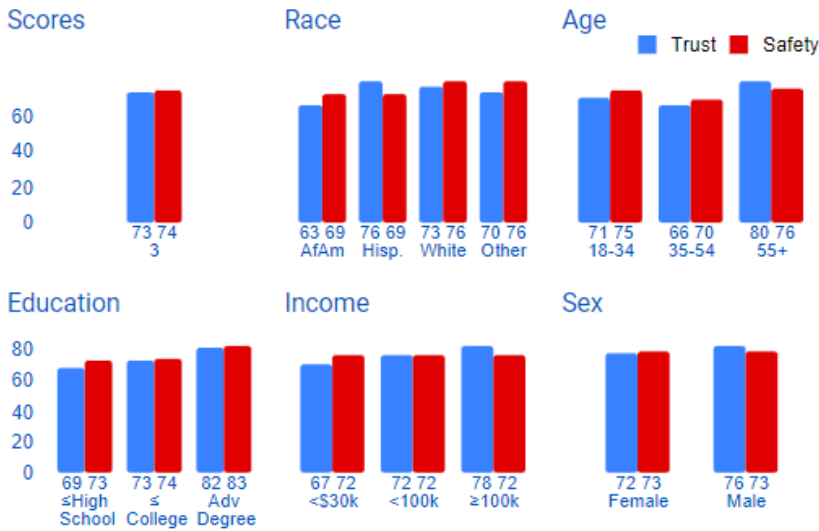

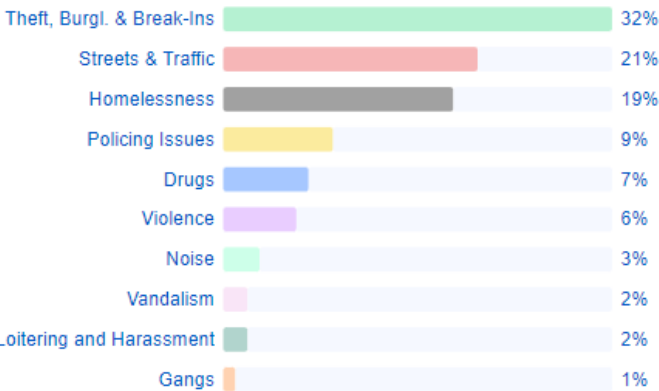

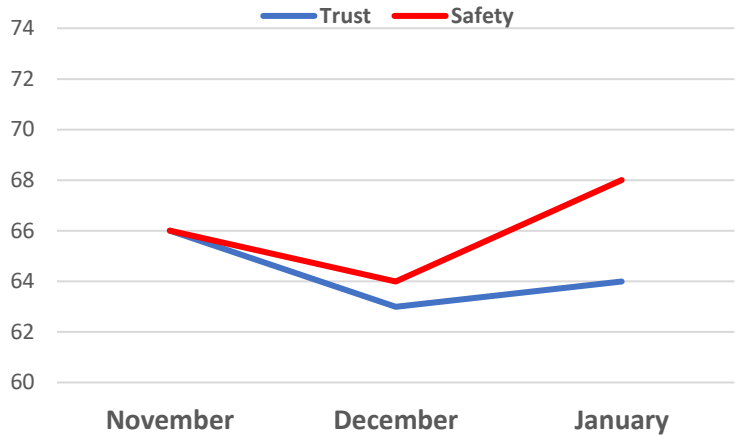

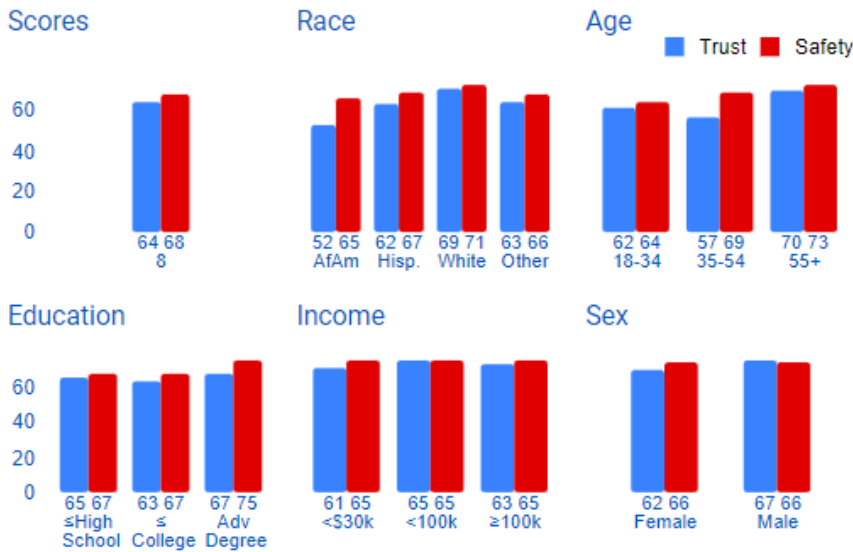

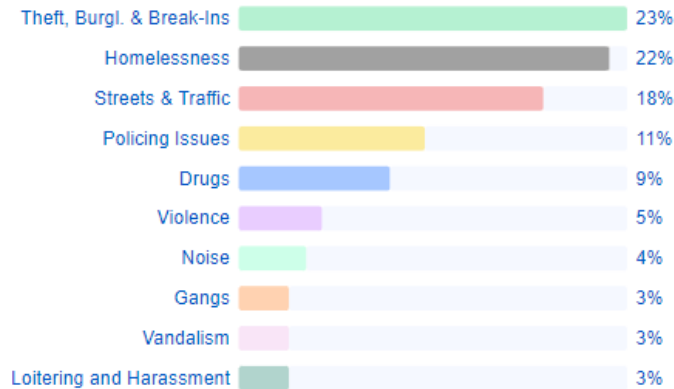

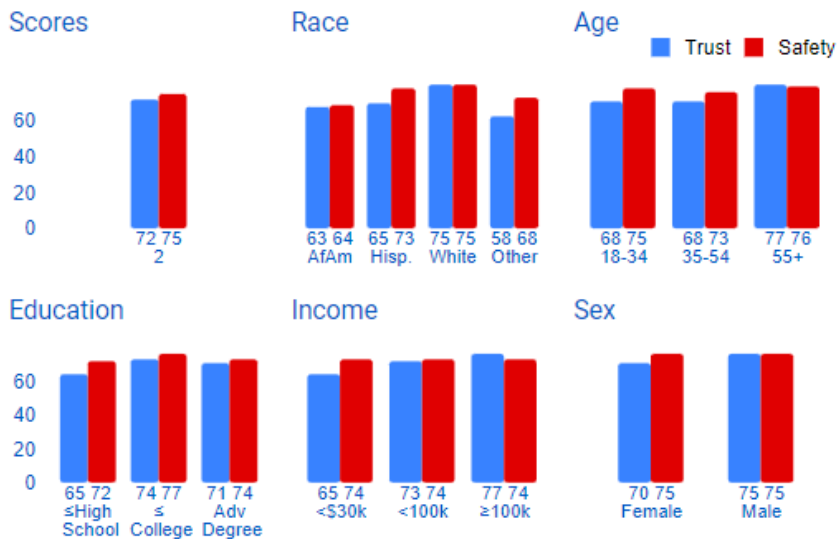

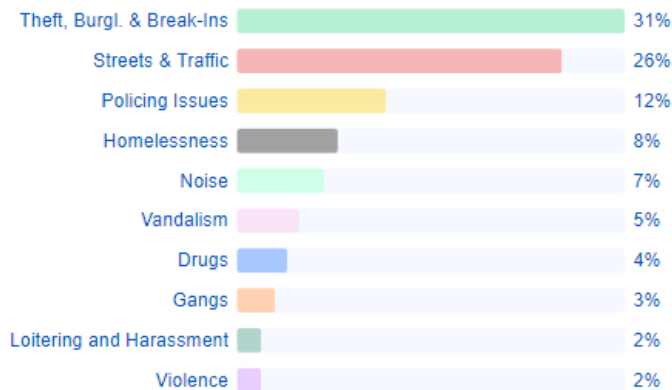
Theft, Burglary and Break-Ins. was the main concern for the division (31%), followed by Streets & Traffic (26%) and Policing Issues (12%).

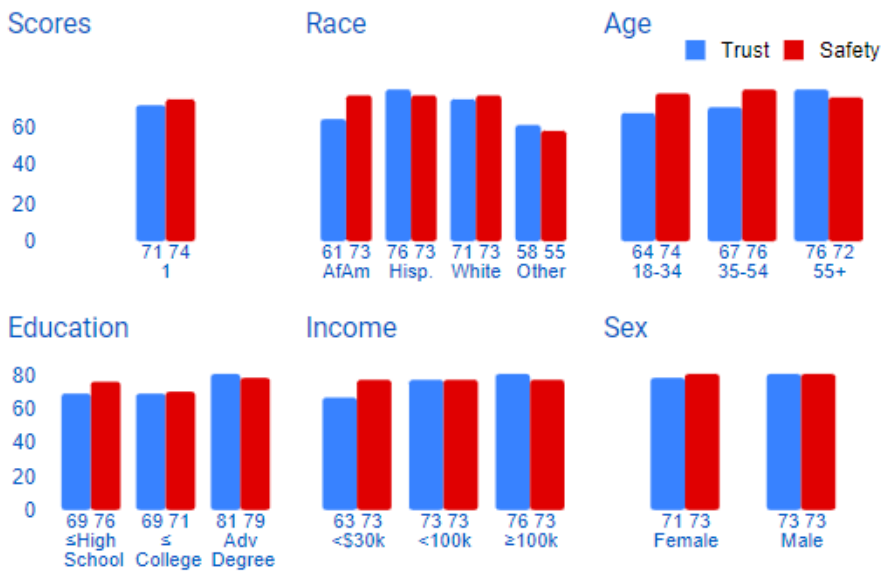

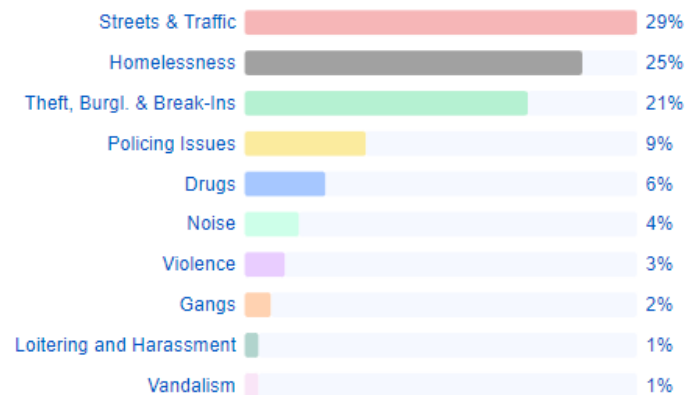

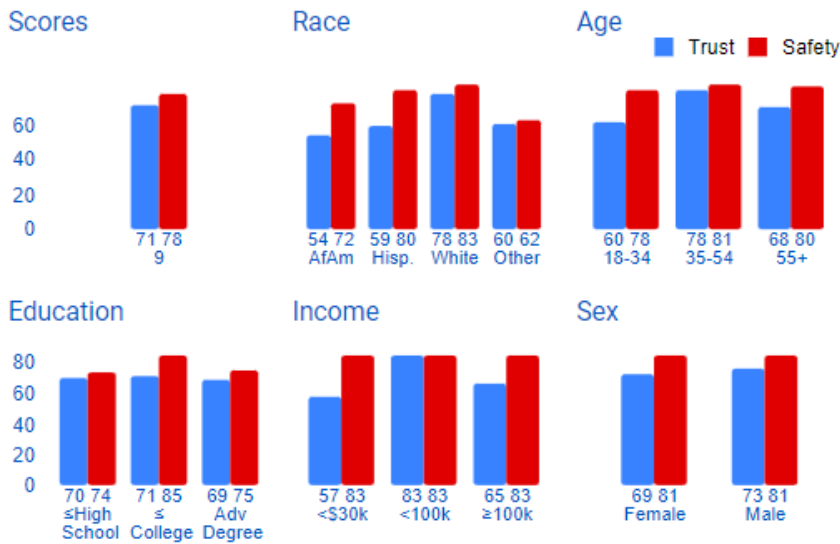

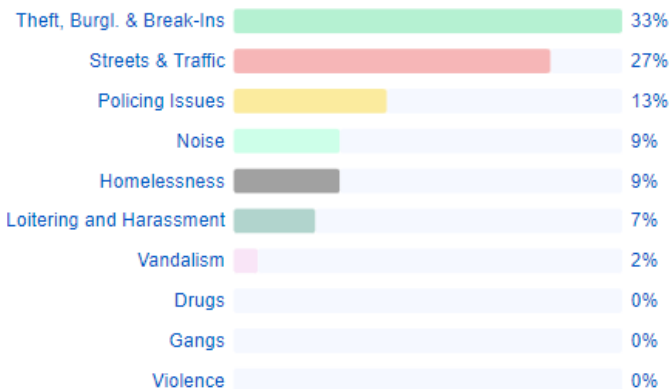

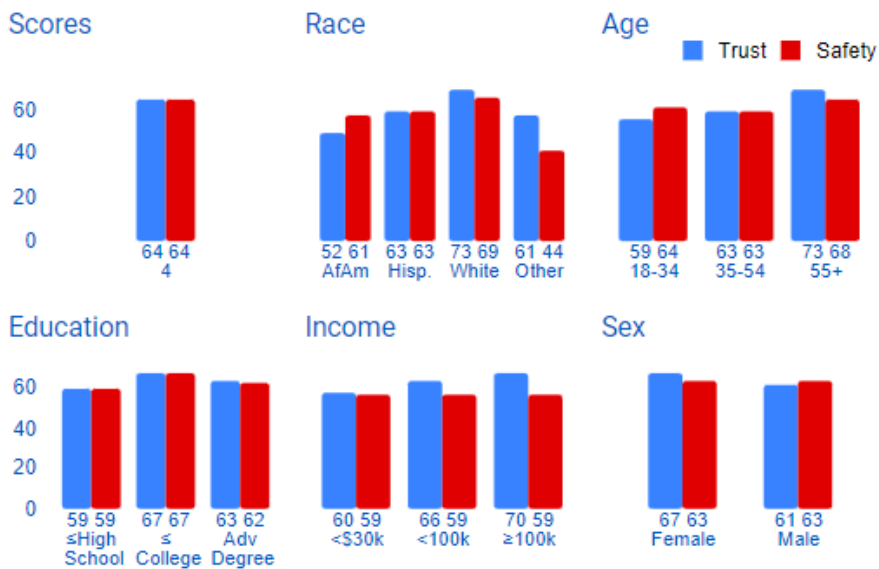

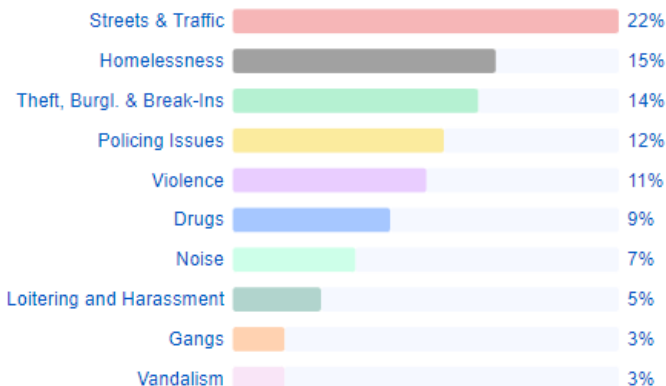

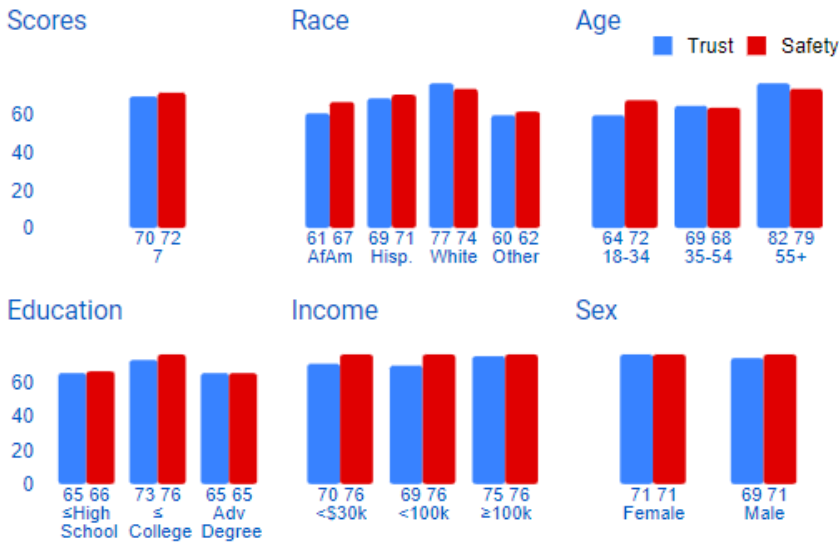

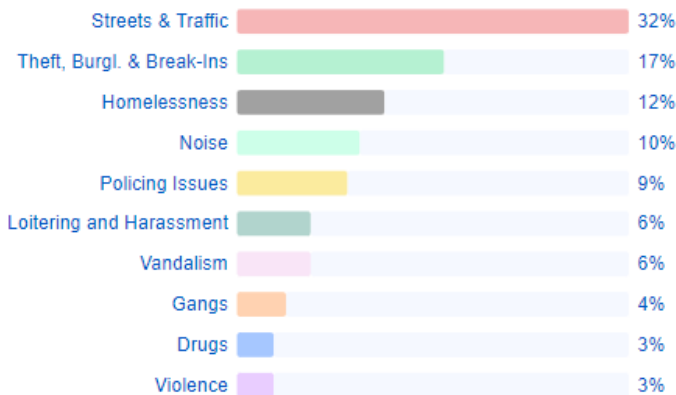

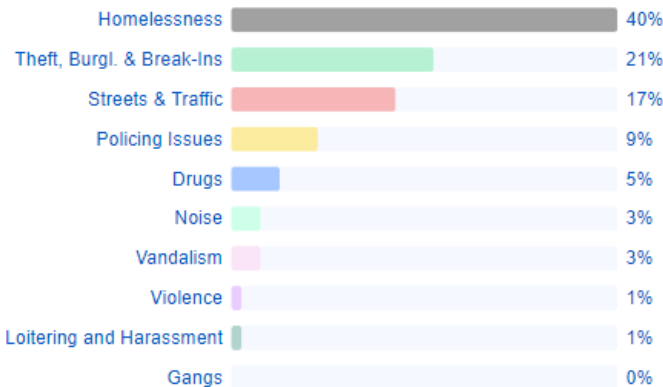
