



Summary


Citywide Trust (68) was stable and remained the same compared to February. Among the nine divisions, the most significant changes in Trust scores were a 3-point decrease in Southern (66), and 3-point increases in Northeastern (75) and Western (67). Citywide Safety (70) was also stable compared to February, with a 2-point increase for Northeastern (78) and a 2-point drop for Southeastern (63).

Citywide the top concerns were Theft, Burglaries & Break-Ins, Homelessness and Streets & Traffic (22% for all three categories).




Safety Heatmap





Trust for Central Division was up by 2 points compared to the previous month (59). Safety for the division was down by 1 point compared to the previous month (60).

Homelessness was by far the main concern for the division (39%, last month – 40%), followed by Streets & Traffic and Drugs (both 14%) and Theft, Burglary and Break-Ins (13%).




Trust for Eastern Division was up by 1 point compared to the previous month (74). Safety for the division was stable and remained the same compared to the previous month (74).

Theft, Burglary and Break-Ins. was the main concern for the division (27%), followed by Homelessness (22%) and Streets & Traffic (20%).






Summary


Trust for Northern Division was down by 1 point compared to the previous month (72). Safety for the Northern division was also down by 1 point compared to the previous month (72).






Trust for Southeastern Division was stable and remain the same compared to the previous month (63). Safety for the division was down by 2 points compared to the previous month (65).

Streets & Traffic was the main concern for the division (21%), followed by Homelessness and Theft, Burglary and Break-Ins. (both 15%).






Trust for Southern Division was down by 3 points compared to the previous month (66), marking a 9-point drop since November. Safety for the district was down by 1 point compared to the previous month (68).

Streets & Traffic remained the main concern for the division (28%, compared to 30% last month) followed by Theft, Burglary and Break-Ins (21%) and Homelessness (12%).


