Police Investigate Homicide in North Park Neighborhood

San Diego – Just after 7:10 a.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received several calls reporting gunshots and a person down at 4500 Kansas Street.

Officers from Mid-City Division arrived at the location and found an unresponsive male with an apparent gunshot injury on the sidewalk. Officers performed life saving measures until relieved by San Diego Fire-Rescue personnel. Unfortunately, the male succumbed to his injuries at the scene.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and are currently investigating the incident. It is early in the investigation and little is known about the circumstances surrounding the man's death. Detectives have learned the male may have been involved in an altercation with a Hispanic male in his 40's wearing jeans and a zip-up top. He was last seen northbound on Kansas Street in a small, older vehicle. Detectives are collecting evidence and attempting to locate witnesses.

The male has been identified, however his name is not being released at this time. He is described as a 37 year-old Hispanic male.
