Police Investigate Homicide in Barrio Logan Neighborhood

San Diego – On February 25, 2021, just after 11:30 p.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received calls reporting a disturbance outside a home at 2100 National Avenue. It was also reported that a male with gunshot injuries had entered the home and was down inside.

Officers from Central Division arrived at the location and were directed to the injured male inside the bathroom of the residence. The officers discovered an unresponsive male with at least one apparent gunshot wound. Officers performed life saving measures until relieved by San Diego Fire-Rescue personnel. In spite of this, the male succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased at the scene at midnight.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and are currently investigating the incident. While it is still early the investigation, Detectives have learned that two males were in an argument outside the home when one of the males forced his way into the home. Several gunshots were fired inside the home and other residents found the injured man in the bathroom. It is unknown at this time if the male was known to the residents of the home.

Detectives currently have no suspect description.

The male has not yet been identified, however he is described as a Hispanic male in his late 20's to early 30's.
