Search Warrant Results in Arrests and Seizure of Firearms and Narcotics

San Diego – The San Diego Police Department’s Narcotics Unit served a search warrant yesterday as part of a two-month long investigation in the Normal Heights neighborhood. The search warrant resulted in the seizure of 21 firearms, over \$33,000 and illegal narcotics. Two men were arrested.

During the course of the investigation, SDPD’s Narcotics Unit detectives gathered evidence involving narcotics activity. The SWAT unit served the warrant at a home on the 4400 block of 32nd Street. During the search of the home, 21 firearms, body armor and ammunition were confiscated. Additionally, more than 1000 Adderall pills, 200 Xanax pills, fentanyl, cocaine and methamphetamine along with over \$33,000 in cash was found.

38-year-old Troy Garland was placed under arrest for a felon in possession of a firearm along with narcotics related charges. 41-year-old Daniel Mancarella was arrested for four outstanding felony warrants.
