Police Investigate Homicide in Lincoln Park

San Diego – At approximately 7:00 p.m. on April 2, 2021, San Diego Police Officers were in the area of the 47th Street Trolley Station when they were flagged down regarding a possible shooting in a cul-de-sac on the south side of the trolley platform. When the officers reached the area, they found a male down on the ground who had sustained an apparent gunshot wound. The officers rendered aid, and eventually CPR, until being relieved by paramedics. Unfortunately, the man succumbed to his wounds and was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Citizens directed officers to a possible suspect hiding in a backyard of a residence in the 4800 block of Hartley Street. A male was taken into custody without incident and is being held for questioning. We do not believe any suspects are outstanding at this time. A gun was recovered at the scene.

Investigators from the San Diego Police Homicide Unit were called to the scene to investigate the shooting. The detectives are in the process of gathering evidence and interviewing witnesses to determine the circumstances leading to the shooting.

The victim has been identified but his name is not being released at this time. He is described as a 44 year-old Black male.

The person who was detained for further questioning has been identified but his name is not being released at this time. He is described as a 34 year-old Black male.
