Update on Suspicious Death in Ocean Beach

San Diego – On Friday, May 21, 2021, just before 11:30 p.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a call reporting that an unresponsive male was down in an alley at 4800 Niagara Avenue in Ocean Beach.

Officers from Western Division arrived at the location and found the male in the north alley. The male was unresponsive and a citizen was performing CPR. Officers and San Diego Fire-Rescue personnel took over life-saving measures. Unfortunately, the male was pronounced deceased at the scene at 11:41 p.m.

Due to the suspicious nature of the death, San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and began investigating the incident. During the course of the investigation, detectives learned the male died as a result of a traffic collision. The investigation has been turned over to the Traffic Investigations Unit for further follow-up.

The deceased male has been identified as Frank Thomas Neal, 60, of San Diego.
