Central Division Arrests Suspects for Multiple Robberies.

San Diego- On Monday, June 12, 2017 at 2349 hours, five unknown males took a victim's phone and wallet after punching and threatening him at 100 Park Boulevard. Fifteen minutes later a male was sleeping on 800 J Street when he was attacked by at least four males. A second robbery occurred at 0058 hours. During this incident, one of the suspects used a broom to repeatedly strike the victim and take his property. At 0125 hours two suspects approached two individuals. The two suspects began punching one of them in the face, knocking him to the ground, and started to rob him. Two Central Division officers witnessed the incident and stopped the robbery. The suspects went in different directions, but after a short foot pursuit, 19-year-old Thomas Munford was taken into custody. Other officers responding to assist located the second suspect nearby, a juvenile, and took him into custody.

Thomas Munford was booked into County jail and the juvenile was processed and booked into Juvenile Hall.

Munford was booked on the following charges:

2. 496(a) PC-Possession of Stolen Property
3. 245 (a)(1) PC-Assault with a Deadly Weapon
4. 243 (a) PC-Battery on a Person
5. 148 (a)(1) PC-Obstruction
