Chief's Statement Regarding the Passing of two SDPD Detectives

San Diego – It is with a heavy heart that I announce the tragic passing of two of our own San Diego Police Detectives.

This morning, Detective Ryan Park and his wife, Detective Jamie Huntley-Park, were traveling southbound on I-5 when they were struck and killed by a wrong-way driver.

Because this incident took place on the freeway, the California Highway Patrol will be conducting the investigation.

Detectives Ryan Park and Jamie Huntley-Park were both hired as police recruits on the same day, a little over nine years ago. They were promoted to Detective on the same day, almost three years ago. Ryan was assigned to the Homicide Unit and Jamie was assigned to Southern Division Investigations. Both were beloved, dedicated, and decorated public servants.

I want to extend my sincere condolences to Jamie and Ryan's loved ones. I also ask for the San Diego community to keep their thoughts and prayers with Jamie and Ryan's families during this difficult time.
