Identifications Made In Barrio Logan Homicide Investigation

San Diego – At 3:40 p.m. on June 24, 2021, the San Diego Police Communications Center received a call of a possible deceased woman in an apartment in the 2800 block of Boston Avenue. The caller said he has tried to reach his mother throughout the day but was unsuccessful. When he came to the apartment to check on her, he found his brother inside. He eventually saw his mother in the bathroom and believed she was deceased. A fight ensued between the brothers, with the initial brother eventually leaving the apartment and calling police. When the patrol officers arrived, they took the second brother into custody and found the mother deceased inside the residence. The brother who was detained was transported to a local hospital for treatment from injuries he sustained during the fight with his brother.

Investigators from the San Diego Police Homicide Unit were called to the scene. It is still early in the investigation and little is known about the circumstances leading up to the woman's death. Investigators continue to process evidence and interview witnesses to determine what may have led to the homicide.

The deceased woman has been identified as 64 year-old Francisca Agundez.

The suspect has been identified as 30 year-old Marco Agundez, the son of the deceased. He remains in police custody at a local hospital for treatment of injuries he received during the fight with his brother.
