



Unknown Suspect Wanted for Armed Robbery Up to a \$1,000 Reward Offered

December 23, 2015

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Robbery Unit are asking for assistance from the public to help identify and locate the suspect wanted for an armed robbery at a Tapioca Express store in the University City area.

On December 18, 2015, at approximately 11:00 p.m., an unknown suspect walked into the Tapioca Express store located at 7770 Regents Road, in San Diego. The suspect, who was armed with a small black handgun, approached the cashier. The suspect took cash from the register and walked out of the store. No vehicle was seen leaving the parking lot.

Suspect Description: Asian or Hispanic male, in his 20's, 5'7" tall, 145 to 150 lbs, black hair, brown eyes, wearing a light grey hooded sweatshirt, dark colored pants, a green bandana covering his face, and white tennis shoes. The suspect was armed with a small black handgun.
