Police Investigate Homicide and Shooting in Lincoln Park

San Diego – On December 21, 2021, at 5:22 p.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received multiple 911 calls regarding a shooting at 200 50th Street in the Lincoln Park neighborhood.

When officers from Southeastern Division arrived, they found two males down in the street. Both had been struck by gunfire. The first victim, described as a 59-year-old Black male, has been identified, however his name is not being released at this time. He was transported to a local hospital where, unfortunately, he was pronounced deceased.

The second victim, described as a 64-year-old black male, has also been identified, however his name is not being released at this time. He was transported to a local hospital for treatment. His injuries are serious, but he is expected to survive.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene. It is early in the investigation and detectives are still working to determine the circumstances surrounding the shooting. Preliminary information indicates that the victims were part of a group gathered on 50th Street. The suspect approached them on foot and fired multiple rounds at the group before fleeing.

The suspect information is limited at this point. The suspect is believed to be a Black male wearing dark clothing, including a hooded sweatshirt and a mask. The suspect's vehicle is possibly a white or silver Honda sedan.
