MY BUSINESS ENGAGEMENTS RENDER IT IM-
POSSIBLE FOR ME TO MEET YOU, AS YOU REQUEST. THEREFORE, I
MAKE A WRITTEN REPORT WHICH I HOPE MAY DO AS WELL.

UNDER MY CONTRACT WITH THE CITY I AGREED
TO ESTABLISH STREET CENTRES AND MAKE PROFILES OF GRADES OVER
A GIVEN TERRITORY WHICH I HAVE DONE. SOME OF THEM I
BROUGHT BEFORE THE BOARD AND THEY ACTED ON THEM, BUT THE LAST
TIME YOU SAID FOR ME TO TURN THEM OVER AS FAST AS FINISHED
TO CITY ENGINEER WHEELER, WHICH I DID OVER TWO MONTHS AGO.

MR. WHEELER AND I WENT OVER THEM TO-GETH-
ER AND THE GRADES WERE MADE TO SUIT HIM. I HAVE ALSO SET
ALL THE STREET CENTRES.

THE BILL I NOW RENDER INCLUDES THE
COST OF THE MAP I MADE FOR COL. SELGWICK; THE SURVEYING I
DID FOR THE GRADING AT THE RUSS SCHOOL HOUSE; AND GIVING GRADES
FOR THE ELECTRIC LIGHT MASTS AND GUYS.

ALSO I HAVE PUT IN A CHARGE FOR MY TIME
AS SUPERINTENDENT OF STREETS, FOR POSTING NOTICES ON THE
STREETS THAT WERE ORDERED GRADED BUT HAVE NOT YET BEEN FIN-
ISHED.
