Gentlemen:-

I understand that part of the so
called Torrey Pines Grade lies within your
jurisdiction.

It has come to my notice on several
different occasions the importance of protecting
the motorists on this grade, and I wish to take
this opportunity of calling your attention to
same and submitting a plan by which I believe
a certain amount of accidents will be eliminated.

I will use my best efforts to have
this grade thoroughly sign-posted with caution
signs and would suggest that your body with the
cooperation of the City officials take steps to
have white fencing put up on all the dangerous
points on this grade. This can be done at a
very nominal expense and will insure to those
drivers that come in from Los Angeles, after
dark, and are not familiar with the grade, that
they will reach their destination with safety
as far as that particular piece of road is con-
cerned.

I have recently taken up with the
city the same thing on the other grades and
they have consented to comply with my sug-
gestion.
