Mr. President and Gentlemen:

Referring to Document 113880, returned herewith, being a communication from Nina B. Brust, Secretary of the Society for Prevention of Tuberculosis, would say that the same has been given my attention this morning. May I state that this matter has been acted upon by the San Diego County Medical Society, and, also, by Dr. P. M. Carrington.

It seems that the Federal authorities cannot give transportation to discharged soldiers in place of money.

Next, the fact that the majority of the discharged men are suffering from the incipient tuberculosis, not active. This has been explained to Mrs. Brust in my previous communications.
