Gentlemen:-

At a called meeting of the San Diego County Medical Society Nov. 1, 1918, the following resolutions were unanimously passed, in response to your request of October 31st, 1918:


"We do not recommend the quarantining of the City of San Diego, but we endorse the present action of the Board of Health in quarantining individual cases of influenza.


"We recommend the wearing of masks only (1) by those in contact with cases or suspected cases of influenza; (2) in crowded places, such as street cars.

"We suggest that proper regulations be issued by the Board of Health for the sterilization of said masks; and we endorse the spraying at present used (sulphate or bisulphate of quinine $\frac{1}{2}$ - 10,000) as a useful measure, but recommend that the Board of Health formulate regulations to guard against abuses of this valuable protection.
