To the Honorable, The Mayor and  
The Common Council, of the  
City of San Diego, California.

Gentlemen:

The following resolution was unanimously adopted  
at a meeting held by the Board of Health on November 30th:

"Resolved, that the schools, including private  
schools and business colleges, churches, lodges,  
theatres, moving picture shows, bath houses,  
dance halls, rest rooms in stores, and saloons  
be closed, that all public or social gatherings  
of any character, auctions, women's weekly club  
meetings, monthly dinner parties, unnecessary  
sales in stores that may cause gatherings, gather-  
ings in hotel lobbies, and unnecessary visits to  
stores by women or men who have no idea of pur-  
chasing goods, shall be prohibited."

The Board of Health requests that the Common Council  
pass an ordinance embracing the above resolution, embodying  
in the same any further measures which they may deem necessary  
for the care and protection of public health.

It is requested that this ordinance be made an  
emergency measure, the same to go into effect at midnight,  
December 2nd.
