Your check in the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000) Dollars, made payable to the Treasurer of the City of San Diego, was received by the Board of Park Commissioners at its last meeting, and the following resolutions was adopted;

Scripps, on behalf of the citizens of San Diego, a vote of thanks and appreciation for her exceeding generosity in donating the sum of Five Thousand Dollars to the Torrey Pines Park Improvement Fund, thereby making possible the construction of a suitable lodge and other necessary improvements to this beautiful spot.

Be it further resolved that the net proceeds from the operation of the Torrey Pines lodge, or from the rental of the premises be expended entirely upon the maintenance of and improvement to Torrey Pines Park."
