Dear Sir:

In response to your letter of April 8th, 1922, suggesting the transfer of the funds recently appropriated and set aside by the Common Council for the construction of a comfort station and lodge in Torrey Pines Park, permit me to advise you that in my opinion the creation of a new fund for the handling of moneys set aside into separate funds for separate purposes could not legally be effected. Further, that the Board of Park Commissioners has already been authorized to draw against the proposed funds for the purpose designated in the original ordinances, and that the matter now simply requires the issuance of the necessary requisitions.

I shall be pleased to explain this to you orally at any time which may meet with your convenience.
