By action of the Board of Park Commissioners on June 23, last, you were authorized to prepare plans and specifications for the proposed Torrey Pines Lodge along the general lines of the sketch submitted to you by Mr. J.C.Harper, of La Jolla, and by him approved. Your charges, of course, will be based upon the schedule already submitted by you to this office.

It is the wish of Miss Scripps, donor of a large portion of the funds necessary for this construction, that the plans be gotten out with all possible expedition, and in this wish the park commissioners heartily concur.

It is suggested that a conference between yourselves and the writer in regard to the manner of handling your account with the city be to our mutual advantage, in that we would be saved the labor of straightening out possible misunderstanding, and you will receive your fees more promptly. This will be handled under provisions of the city purchasing ordinance.
